Hollywood Armstrong came out first, accompanied by the Warner Brothers. As they waited in the ring, the arena went dark and blue lasers shined on Armstrong's chest. H2O walked down to the ring accompanied by Nathan Ross as Sympathy for the Devil played.

The match lived up to the main event hype. H2O hit signature moves such as All Washed Up (standing sidekick), Waterfall (Razor's Edge), and Hydro Bomb (buckle bomb into the ring post on the apron.).

Armstrong countered with DDTs, suplexes, and submissions. In one highlight, Armstrong overhead belly-to-belly suplexed H2O off the ring apron onto the announce table. Later, Armstrong had H2O positioned for a Beverly Hills Backbreaker, but H2O reversed into a Hydro Spike (double underhook piledriver).

At that point, Sam Warner distracted the ref, while Jimmy slipped into the ring and surprised H2O by clipping his knee from behind. Nathan Ross chased Jimmy out of the ring and around the ringside area. Armstrong capitalized on H2O's distraction, hitting him with a low blow followed by a Beverly Hills Backbreaker. Unfortunately for Armstrong, the ref was out of position due to the ongoing shenanigans at ringside. By the time he was ready to count, H2O kicked out at 2.5. Armstrong worked the knee that Jimmy weakened. He locked H2O in figure-four. H2O screamed in pain, but he eventually rolled over and reversed the pressure, until Armstrong reached the ropes.

After a few minutes, H2O and Armstrong started exchanging punches. H2O landed an uppercut that stunned Armstrong. He then ran into the ropes and drilled Armstrong with a Lazer Beam (inverted bulldog). H2O lifted Armstrong to the top turnbuckle. His injured knee slowed him down a step, but H2O executed an Ultimate Eradication (Dragon-screw legwhip off the top. H2O holds on after impact for a kneebar submission.) After an impressive attempt at getting to the ropes, Armstrong tapped out.

When H2O limped over to get his Icon Title, Jimmy Warner reached through the ropes and smashed him in the face with a chair. Sam and Jimmy climbed into the ring, and Ross ran in to even things up. After a brief two-on-one fight, Jimmy threw his chair at Ross. When Ross caught the chair, Sam hit Sweet Chin Music slamming the chair into Ross's head. Ross fell to the canvas busted open. Both Warner brothers pounced on Ross with a flurry of kicks. The Warners then spike piledrivered H2O onto the chair, with Jimmy going to the middle rope for more leverage, leaving the crowd stunned.

The camera flashes to the back showing that other members of AE parked a forklift in front of the EE Army's locker room, trapping Marvel and Blood inside. In the ring, the Warners hit Ross with an assisted powerbomb onto the chair. H2O struggled to get to his feet, surprising the Warners and the crowd. Sam Warner grabbed H2O in a giant swing. Jimmy Warner climbed to the top rope and smashed H2O with an elbow drop, right as Sam swung him into position. As the Pay Per View went off the air, the Warners were celebrating in the ring, and a furious looking H2O was struggling to use the ropes to get to his feet.

(He spins once, pointing at the camera with intensity.)

"And now... now everybody in the back, listen good, sí? Champions don't rest! Campeones don't hide! I am ready for todos—anybody, everybody! You want the All-Star Title? You come see me! You step in the ring... and you try your luck!"

(He leans closer, voice dropping with confidence.)

"But be careful what you wish for, eh... because when you step to Super Dazzle, you step into the light. And the light? It burn you. I am the champion again... the face of ASL... the most brillante star in the sky! And every challenger who come my way..."

(He points straight into the lens, smiling wide.)

"I'll dazzle you with all my great moves!"

(He throws his arms out as the camera fades, the title gleaming under the lights.)

EEArmy Has Been Warned...



Next cycle we'll hear from "Showboat" Sam Warner on what the EE Army can be expecting as they head towards a clash with the Warner Bros and the Arrogant Empire....

(The camera fades into the Oscars red carpet. Stars mill about. Fans cry out for selfies or autographs. Suddenly, the tone changes. People murmur and point. H2O walks into view. He seems profoundly uncomfortable wearing an expensive suit with the ASL Icon title over one shoulder. Nathan Ross, also wearing an expensive suit, is doing his job as a bodyguard--for once. A reporter lady approaches. Ross appears ready to pounce, but H2O sighs and signals to stand down.)

Reporter: Welcome to the 2026 Oscars!

(H2O grumbles.)

Reporter: What brings you to the Oscars?

H2O: I'm the Icon Champion of the All Star League, and I'm wrestling **Hollywood Armstrong** at Clash of the Stars. The brand synergy was too much to pass up. At least that's what the ASL's PR flack told me.

Reporter: You must be thrilled to be here.

H2O: Honestly, I'd rather get hit in the head with a chair than sit in one here tonight. These "cool kids" would never spare me a second glance if I didn't have a big gold belt on my shoulder. These phonies aren't my people. Dressing in their fancy clothes, going to their hedonistic parties, in their swanky clubs. And just waiting for me to slip so they can point their noses in the air and mock me, so they can dismiss me, so they can call me a fai ..

(H2O temporarily loses his temper as he cannot force himself to say the word. The reporter, not a wrestling fan, has no idea what's happening. H2O struggles to get his emotions under control.)

H2O: But, as champion, my duty is to promote the ASL. I'm suffering through this farce so that people tune to Clash of the Stars and watch something real. But, so help me God, if even one person calls me a fai ..

(The reporter cuts H2O off sensing that he might be on the verge of losing his temper again.)

Reporter: Well, I have no idea why anyone would say that to you. But, moving on, you say that you want people to watch something real? I heard a rumor that wrestling is fake.

(H2O sneers at the reporter and speaks in a voice backed with cold steel.)

H2O: You heard wrong.

Reporter: OK, let's try to get back on track. Do you have a favorite movie that you're rooting for tonight?

H2O: The only movie I watched was KPOP Demon Hunters, and I'm pretty sure that Blood only insisted on watching that because he thought it might be about one of his relatives.

Reporter: Well, is there any actor or actress that you're hoping to meet. All of the big stars are out tonight.

(H2O looks at the reporter like she's insane. He grabs the microphone from the startled reporter.)

H2O: Armstrong, it must tear you apart that I'm here while you're watching from your couch. You have a Hall of Fame career. You used to be in Edge, a cool kids club almost as revolting as this place. If someone didn't know better, they might think that you were on top, and I was the underdog. That's what the voices

in my head whisper. But I do know better. Despite all outward appearances, you envy me. (H2O points to the Icon Title). I'm the champion, and you're just another challenger.

(The reporter tries to get her mic back. Ross gives her a look which suggests that doing so would be a very poor decision.)

H2O: Armstrong, I see what inspires you, and it's pitiful. At Clash of the Stars, you won't find any of this phoniness. That's why I love wrestling. No one has to pretend to be genteel, or that they love people that they actually hate. It's raw honesty, two men fighting for respect, to win a title, and ultimately to prove who's better. But, as anyone who has seen the trailer already knows—I'm better. Hollywood
ARMSTRONG, PREPARE TO BE ERADICATED.

(H2O flips the mic into the air and lets it fall to the ground as the camera fades out.)

(The camera fades into the room where the EE Army often watches promos. **The Mighty Deadhead's** promo from March 2026 is playing. Everyone looks uncomfortable. Nathan Ross looks sickened. Blood is covering his eyes. H2O seems bored and annoyed.)

Blood: I think I'm going to puke. No one warned me that there would be *romance*.

Marvel: In my expert psychiatric opinion, Deadhead is a pitiful lonely man who knows that he is unlovable. So, he goes on television and makes believe that someone could think he is worthy of love. It's pathetic self-deception.

Ross: The man spends way too much time on his hair. But at least he still has hair, unlike that baldy **Gunther McKidwatcher** after losing that hair vs. hair match.

(Everyone laughs at bald Gunther.)

H2O: It's been a while since we feuded, but I don't think Gunther was Scottish.

(Ross shrugs his shoulders.)

Ross: Who knows. It's not like it's his entire personality or anything.

H2O: Deadhead, you make it difficult to take you seriously. With your overproduced, self-serious, adult-film promos. But I won't let the clown show fool me. I've been in the ring with you, and I know you're dangerous. Good. I want to face the best, wrestlers who will help me elevate the PWI title. The time for fun and games is over, let's go to war.

Blood: Just promise me one thing.

H2O: What? That I'll go to violent extremes that make your old gods proud? That I'll spill enough of Deadhead's blood to water your plants back on Blood World?

Blood: No. Promise me that next time we will fast forward past the mushy parts.

H2O: I promise. After I beat Deadhead, we can fast forward past his promos entirely. Mighty Deadhead, PREPARE TO BE ERADICATED.

(The camera fades out).

(The camera fades into a quiet moment in the EEArmy locker room. Marvel sits alone on a folding chair, staring at his league championship. Outside, the fully group of Blood, Lucky the 3-Legged Dog, Stinky McReeky, Sugarfoot, and Rick O'Shea are heard laughing and arguing. A brief smile flashes across Marvel's face before a serious look returns to his eyes.)

Marvel: The ASL league championship. Do you notice me now?!

DO YOU SEE ME NOW?!

Marvel: For too long, I've been an afterthought. All the focus paid to my EEArmy teammate. And for good reason. H2O had the most successful return to IWA in the history of this sport and it is not even close.

Not even a delusional maniac like Gunther can ignore that H2O had the most impressive year in the IWA.

Marvel: And Blood has seen great success. He may not be entirely sane but she sure is effective. And he is moments way from capturing the Mr. ASL title and being an undeniable force here.

(Outside Blood is heard arguing with Sugarfoot about whether his dancing could spawn demons to cross over from something called the "Cha Cha Potal in Blood World.")

Marvel: **And all this time, I have been biding my time. Building to my moment. The moment when I usher back in the era of sanity and save us from this madness.**

(Marvel takes a deep breath)

Marvel: And the moment is now. I will not be ignored. I cannot be ignored any longer. I am the ASL League Champion. I am an ASL TV-Tag Team Champion. I won the Battle Royal. And soon, I am going to lead my team to glory at Stablecade.

Ignore me at your peril.

Marvel: Whether it's Billy Blunt or someone who unfortunately and hilariously calls himself "Doctor Pain." Or if it's the Brand. Or if its Super Dazzle. Or if it's Johnny B himself. I will save you from your madness.

(The camera fades).

EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND
POST-MATCH INCIDENT REPORT**

The crowd inside the Edinburgh arena was still buzzing from Logan Howlett's gutsy thirty-minute-plus performance over Krusty McDoogle when the celebration turned ugly in a hurry.

Howlett had barely finished soaking in the crowd reaction, the Procrastinator still fresh in McDoogle's memory, when the lights in the arena flickered once. Just once. That was all the warning anybody got.

Solomon Grundy came through the curtain like a freight train that had lost its brakes somewhere back up the tracks. No music. No announcement. No preamble. Just five hundred pounds of swamp-born fury heading straight for the ring, and the Edinburgh crowd shifting from cheers to screams in about half a second flat.

Howlett turned around too late.

Grundy hit the apron and rolled in under the bottom rope, and the whole ring shook when he got to his feet. Howlett threw up his hands and started talking, which is what Howlett does, which is always the wrong play against a man who does not negotiate and does not listen and genuinely does not care what you have to say.

Grundy grabbed him by the throat with one hand.

One hand.

He held Howlett off the mat just long enough to make a point, then drove him down into the canvas with a chokeslam that sent a ripple through the ring skirt and brought the entire arena to a dead hush. To Becky's left—

Sir Gunther Kinderwacht, jaw clenched, veins visible through his neck, wearing his stretched “**I HATE ROOKIES**” shirt.

To her right—

Sinister Steve Stryker, pacing slowly, eyes cold, fists tightening and relaxing like he's barely holding it together.

There is no laughter tonight.

Becky Boobie

“Ladies and gentlemen... I'm here with Sir Gunther Kinderwacht and Sinister Steve Stryker. And... I have to say, this feels different. The most dominant force in the ASL... but lately—things haven't gone your way. Gunther... what's going on?”

Sir Gunther Kinderwacht

(doesn't even look at Becky at first)

“...Rock bottom.”

He finally turns, eyes burning.

“That's what they're calling it, right?”

That the most dominant force in this league... hit a dry spell.”

He scoffs.

“A slump. A cold streak. A fall from grace.”

He steps forward.

“Let me educate everybody watching...”

“This?”

This is not rock bottom.”

He points to the ground.

“This is the **launch point**.”

Gunther (voice rising)

“Yeah—I lost the Icon title.”

He slaps his chest.

“MY title.”

“And yeah—Steve doesn't have the All Star title right now.”

He gestures beside him.

“But don't get it twisted for a SECOND...”

“We didn't forget how to win.”

“We didn't forget how to dominate.”

Sinister Steve Stryker

(cuts in, voice low and dangerous)

“No... what happened... is we got comfortable.”

He stops pacing and looks straight into the camera.

“And the worst thing you can do... is let killers get comfortable.”

He cracks his neck slowly.

“Because now?”

“Now we're awake.”

Becky Boobie

“And... earlier tonight, Doctor Pain showed up and—”

Gunther (snaps)

“Oh we KNOW what he did!”

He laughs—but there's no humor in it.

“He walked in here with his little toys... his little stories... talking about pigs and results like we're some kind of underperforming rookies.”

He shakes his head.

“You think I enjoyed that?”

“You think I enjoyed being questioned... in MY locker room?”

Steve Stryker

(cold smirk)

“He should’ve done it sooner.”

Gunther turns and looks at Steve—surprised for a split second.

Steve continues.

“Because he wasn’t wrong.”

Silence.

Steve (steps forward)

“We HAVE been off.” “Not bad... not weak...” “Just... not us.”

He points to the ground.

“This place? This league? This was built on fear of names like ours.” “And lately?”

He shrugs.

“People got comfortable.”

Gunther

“And the IWA universe let it happen.”

He spreads his arms in disgust.

“They watched. They cheered. They propped up these... flavor-of-the-month clowns.”

“They handed opportunities to people who haven’t bled for this league the way WE have.”

His voice drops lower.

Here's the thing, though; anyone reading this can do the same thing, so I'm not actually taking from anyone. I'm spreading the love, and that's what miserable people like this can't stand. Ya see, there is absolutely no way that someone with a normal, healthy life outside of this game could possibly spend as much time as this person spends consumed by their standing in it. This dude likely spends more time on the extra stuff in the game than any of the rest of us spend total. I'm not saying it isn't helpful to some, but it clearly isn't healthy.

The good news is, none of this will sway That Guy in the slightest. And thank whatever celestial being he tells us that we must draw comfort from for that. One thing we learn from the internet is that when someone hates you, you should often consider the source and see if this is a backhanded compliment. Sure, there is the chance that he is threatened by me. Looking at the numbers and trying to ask myself, "How would I feel if this were the most important thing in my world," I could see that as a much more likely explanation than any that have been given thus far.

I will give him credit on his rage bait though (again, me responding proves he's already won. Only one person is allowed to speak and control the narrative, and if you defend yourself it's a sign of fragility.
