# HOTSEAT INTERVIEW WITH *Ellie Eddner*

## WITH CWL COMMISSIONER VINCE MARSHAL



Ellie Eddner sat down with Vince Marshall to discuss his vision for the Continental Wrestling League.

EE: Commissioner Marshall, you've already had a huge impact on the CWL with your decision to put Hypnotik in the main event at the next pay-per-view.

VM: You certainly get right to the point, don't you? I like that. First of all, the next pay-per-view will be called New Beginnings. It's only appropriate given the changes I will oversee here.

As to the Hypnotik and Harden Long decision, a decision had to be made and I made it. However, as it has always been made clear, to challenge for a CWL title, you must trash talk. So, if Hypnotik does not submit trash talk, the decision will be changed.

EE: I'm sure you are aware, your predecessor, Samantha Solie, had a war with CWL owner Lazarus Lane. What will prevent history from repeating itself?

VM: I am well aware of the CWL Civil War. I am not new to the business. My dad was a wrestler who was cheated out of his job by a shrewd owner. I had a contract drawn up that would give me full managerial control. There will be no Civil War on my watch.

EE: LePage Turner and Skapegoat and Logan Kane and Chameleon have almost started a second civil war. They are battling for supremacy here in the CWL.

VM: Yes, but that will all be settled at the next IWAR Supershow. The CWL's match will be a team led by LePage Turner and Skapegoat going against a team led by Chameleon and Logan Kane. But let me make one thing clear. Control of the CWL will not ride on the outcome of this match like it did during Civil War.

Wrestlers have disagreements. We do our best to settle those differences while giving the fans the best show.

EE: That kind of fits into your motto, doesn't it?

VM: The wrestlers create the chaos. I control the consequences. Yes, that is my motto exactly.

EE: What plans do you have for those four at New Beginnings?

VM: Skapegoat has a match booked. He is defending his Internet title. I know in the past wrestlers have wrestled multiple matches at pay-per-view events. But I watched my dad wrestle. I know the effects a match has. I won't do that to wrestlers.

EE: What about Logan Kane, Chameleon, and LePage Turner?

VM: I haven't decided that. I imagine Mr. Turner will find himself facing one of those two men. As for the other, the future remains to be seen.

EE: How old are you?

VM: You are forward. How would you like it if I asked you that question? I'm 32.

EE: Some say you're too young to be at the helm of the CWL.

VM: I've done more in my short life than many have done in a lifetime. I've represented wrestlers and other professional athletes as an agent. I've turned around struggling wrestling promotions. My track record speaks for itself.

EE: What changes do you have in store for the CWL?

VM: I'm still evaluating the league. I just got here. I've barely learned all the names of the office staff. I'm sure changes will come in due time. In the meantime, slow and steady wins the race.

EE: Commissioner, I want to wish you the best of the luck in your CWL tenure.

VM: Thanks, Ellie. Keep up the good work. Keep the tough questions coming. You have talent. You have a bright future. Maybe someday you'll sit in my seat.

# VINCE MARSHAL'S MARSHAL LAW



New Beginnings is going to be awesome. The title matches were set at Brawl For It All.

Because the Von Snapps and the New Covenant drew last cycle, and the Von Snapps have been on a roll, they will challenge for the CWL Six-Man title again at New Beginnings.

- 5) Unless otherwise announced, the wrestler with the highest score wins the title. In the event of a tie, the match is considered a draw and the challenger will be a part of the title match at the next pay-per-view.

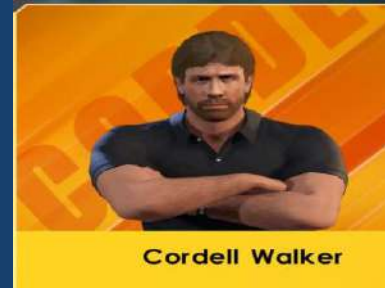

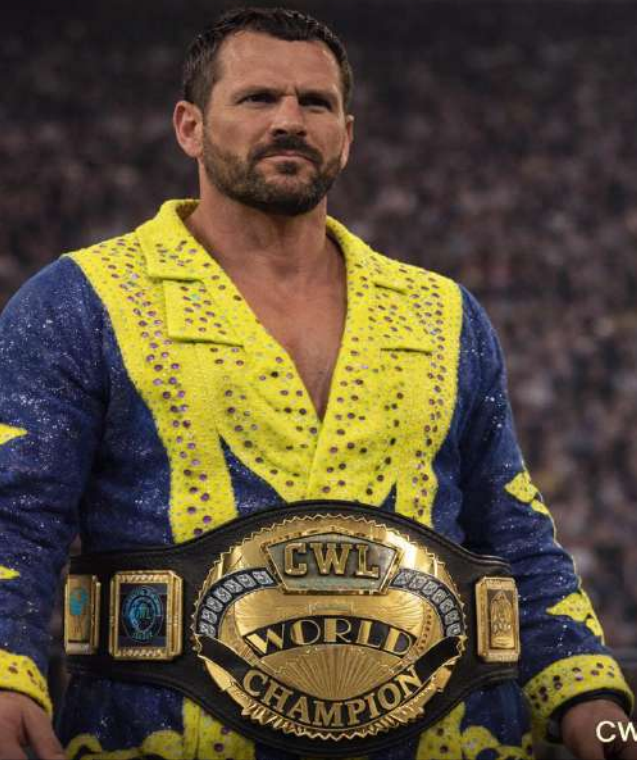

**KANE:** I never said it was going to be an easy process!

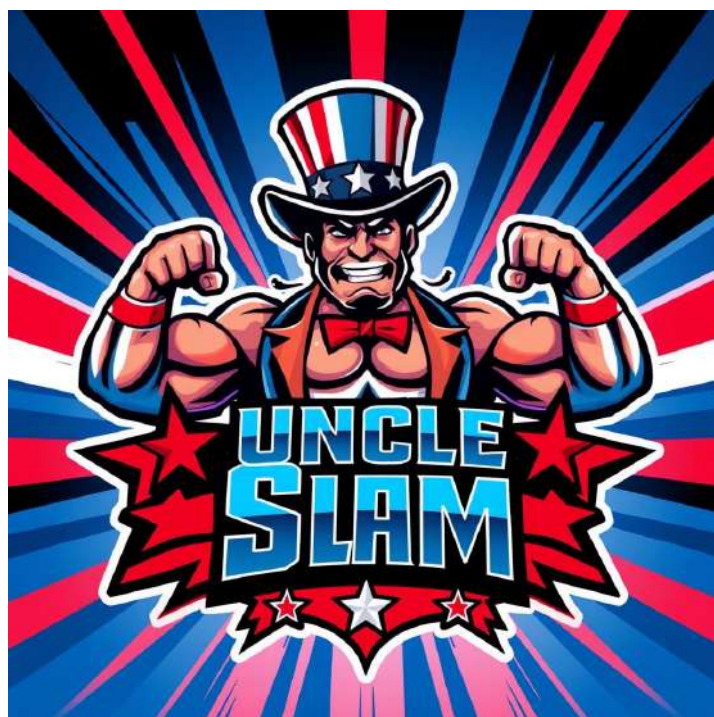
Off The Chameleon's glare —

Dapper Dan Dee: It's been over a year since we've heard from my guest here, "The Broken Diamond," how have you been?

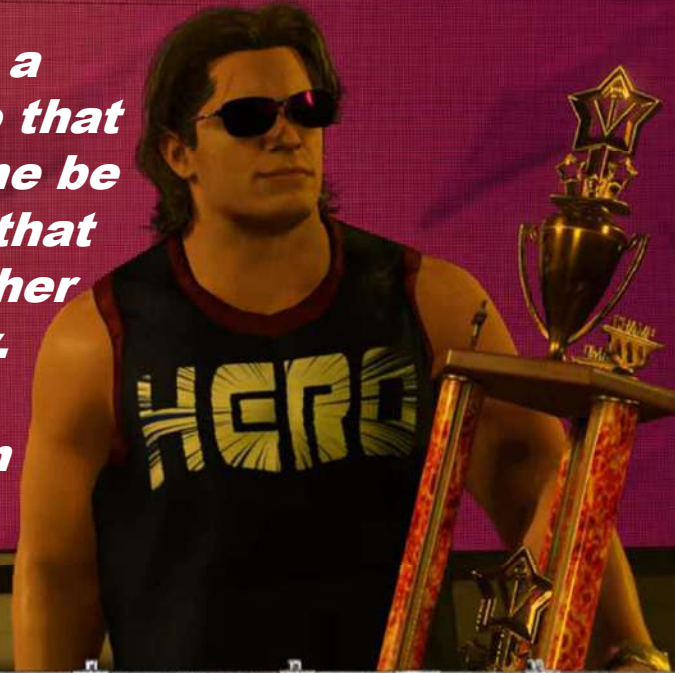
