

(Dane hops on the top rope from the apron and blows fire one more time! The fans love it! He backflips off the top rope and then bows to the crowd. The give respect back.)

<u>Aldo:</u> And his partner, the former NPL All-American Champion, he is one third of the Andersons, he is Huxley Anderson!!!

The fans cheer, as the former NPL All-American Champion Huxley Anderson's music hits. He shoots out the curtain to a roar from the crowd. With rib tape on, he runs over and high fives the fans at ringside. He enters the ring, poses to the crowd and then shakes Dane's hand. Suddenly the lights go out.)

Aldo: (Stammers) Uh...their final partner...San La Muerte!

(A spotlight shoots out of the entranceway, grim music plays, and a chilly fog rolls down the entranceway. A silhouette figure walks into the dim light. He looks up and reaches for the camera. As he gets close, the light goes off. In 6 seconds, the lights come on as thunder rocks the arena. The fans groan as San La Muerte appears between both Huxley and Dane. They stumbled back. Aldo Montoya falls back into the corner in fear. As he pulls back his hood, pyro shoots from the turnbuckles! The fans give a mixed, but impressive reaction to the new NPL talent. The impressive Muerte disrobes. With his hair in his face, he stands ready.)

(After a pause, "Rags2Riches" feat. ATR Son Son by Rod Wave hits. Outwalks Commissioner Jaxx. He's dressed in his usual Gucci suit, platinum chains, watches, and designer shades. Flanked by the Rags2Riches security and lead security Matt. Commissioner Jaxx enters the ring and embraces his team.)

Aldo: And their opponents...Raghu Chopra, Suadet Kraivichien, and Jun-ho Mok!!!

(The fans boo as the cameras cut to the entranceway. First out of the curtain is Jake Duvall. Then the rest of the impressive team. Jake looks into the camera and says, "Commissioner Jaxx doesn't know when he's beaten. He'll learn today." Jake yells at the fans to not touch him. This makes Jun-ho Mok lunge at the fans at ringside. This scares them backwards. They enter the ring behind Jake. Before the match begins, Jake and Jaxx go face-to-face. The ref asks them to separate and go to ringside. They do this as Raghu and Huxley start the match. They lock up and Raghu gets the advantage. He drops Huxley with a bump after coming off the ropes. The two trade reversals and lock ups until Huxley dropkicks Raghu to his corner. Raghu is tagged by Suradet. Jake is taunting Jaxx from the other side of the ring. Jaxx just waves him off as Suradet takes control of the distraction. Suradet drops Huxley with a drop toe hold and side head lock. Huxley pushed Suradet and clotheslines him over the top rope. Huxley then dropkicks Suradet through the 2^{nd} and 1^{st} rope. They brawl up the ramp. This makes the other 4 men brawl on the outside of the ring. The ref loses control of the match. Suradet smashes Huxley into the entranceway board. Huxley gathers himself and forearm smashes Suradet down. The other 4 men join Huxley and Suradet but at the lower part of the ramp. Huxley picks up Suradet and tosses him into the 4 men on the lower part of the entranceway! In doing so, the camera man is behind the 4 men. So he falls and so does the camera! The fans cheer. After a few moments, all 6 men make their way back as the brawl back to the ring. Huxley gets the tag to Dane. The Dragon tries to take the advantage, but Jun-ho stops this with a vicious headbutt. Jun hits a mean sit down powerbomb! The ref covers, 1, 2, no. Huxley kicks Jun in the back. Jun stands

up and sees Dane get the tag to San La Muerte. The fans get loud as the two forces get face-to-face. Neither man speaks. Muerte strikes Jun, who barely moves. Jun tries to strike Muerte who also barely moves. Muerte headbutts Jun. This hurts Muerte's head. He stumbles and then Jun superkicks Muerte down. Jun turns to the crowd to taunt, but as he turns around Muerte is standing back up. Muerte hits hard strikes and a hard powerslam! Only gets a 2 count. Muerte drives Jun into the turnbuckle and strikes. After an Irish whip, Muerte misses a splash in the corner. Jun huts a Samoan Drop on Muerte. Again, Muerte gets up! Jun is in shock and tags in Raghu. Shooting in the ring Raghu dropkicks Muerte and forearms him into the corner. Suradet shoots in and hits his own elbow in the corner. Both men hit Muerte one splash after another. Raghu hits a T-Bone Suplex! Raghu tries to cover, but Huxley flies into the frame which a knee to the back of Raghu's head! 15 seconds go by and up rises San La Muerte. He tags Huxley who sees Raghu get the tag of Suradet. Huxley tries to get the advantage, but Suradet picks up Huxley and hits a Michinoku Driver with Huxley! He covers Huxley and out of nowhere Dane hits a violent superkick to Suradet's face. The smack echoes the arena. The fans groan with every big move. Suradet gets to his feet and tries a powerbomb Huxley, but Muerte chokeslams Suradet! Jun-ho clotheslines Muerte over the top rope. Both men crash to the floor. Legal man Huxley puts his arm over Suradet for the cover. 1, 2, No. Suradet rolls out of the cover. Jun-ho starts tossing monitors, papers, and mics off the announcer's table. Jun-ho screams at the crowd and hits a uranage on Muerte through the announce table! Jake smiles, claps, and gets to the apron to complain to the ref. The camera cuts to Jaxx pulling Jake down off the apron. Jake shoves Jaxx and the Rags2Riches mob Jake. Raghu sees this and springboards off the top rope and lands on the security guys, Jaxx, and Jake! The fans cheer. Huxley tags Dane in. Currently the ref is distracted on what's going on outside the ring. At this moment, Ulysses is seen diving into the ring and smacking Dane in the forehead with a kendo stick! Dane drops. He tries to get up, but Ulysses hits Dane again! This causes Dane to bleed. Ulysses exits through the crowd with a smile on his face. Suradet the legal man, comes over and covers. 1, 2, NO! Huxley breaks up the cover. Huxley pulls Dane over to get the tag. Huxley hits a "Mic-Stomp" on Suradet! He then makes the cover, 1, 2, NO! Commissioner Jaxx's Team wins the Bragging Rights 6-Man Tag Match!)

(Commissioner Jaxx dives into the ring and raises the hand of Huxley. The fans cheer. Seconds later, Dane gets up and crawls over the barricade and jogs through the crowd to go after Ulysses. The cameras cut back to the announce team who is standing at ringside.)

Juice: First match in and we already have a broken table, Dane chasing after Ulysses, Jaxx celebrating his team's victory, and did I mention we have a broken table?!

<u>Bob:</u> It'll get fixed, but how bout that match? Huxley had the League title, and he pulled off a huge win tonight. Is there a title match in his future? Jim? Jim?

Jim: (*Pause*) Sorry gentlemen for the delay. I'm getting word that there's a fight in the back hallway. Can we get some cameras back there?

(The cameras cut to the hallway between dressing rooms where Jun-ho Mok and San La Muerte are brawling in the back. Security is trying to break it up but are getting beat up by the two men. At one-point Jaxx is shoved into some road cases by San La Muerte. Then Jake tries to stop Jun-ho, but Jun shoves Jake to the ground. Finally, Detroit police break up the two men by shocking them multiple times with tasers. The cameras cut back to the ring as the announcers look at each other in shock. Jim speaks.)

Jim: We have a show to do guys. Aldo...

<u>Aldo:</u> The next match is the Finals to determine the #1 Contender for the NPL World Heavyweight Championship Match later in the night. Introducing first, Eisuke Kinugasa!!!

(The fans boo as Eisuke stalks to the ring. He smiles at the crowd as they boo him loudly. A video pops on the screen of how he caused a no contest between Jaxtyn Anderson and "Texas Outlaw" Duke Ken Jr. The fans boo that as Eisuke enters the ring and passive aggressively smiles at the crowd.)

Aldo: And his opponent, Ulysses Deadeye!!!

(Ulysses music hits. He walks through the crowd with Declan and Demitrius Deadeye. They slide into the ring and look to the hard camera. Ulysses mouths "Come get me Dragon!". Eisuke smiles and stands in front of Ulysses. Declan and Demetrious walk towards Eisuke, but Ulysses backs them off. While not taking his eyes off the "Smiling Deceiver" as color commentator Bob Sapp calls him. Declan and Demitrious stand outside of the ring. The bell rings and Demetrious and Eisuke lock up. Eisuke gets the advantage and backs Ulysses into the corner. Eisuke breaks clean, smiles, and then lightly pats Ulysses' face. Deadeye shoves Eisuke and the two begin to brawl. Ulysses hits a drop-toe-hold on Eisuke and then Ulysses drops an elbow on the back of Eisuke's neck! Ulysses then hits a vicious DDT on Eisuke. The ref counts 1,2, no! Moments later, Eisuke gets the advantage back by hitting a dropkick from the top rope. This sends Ulysses out of the ring. Declan and Demitrius help him up slowly. Eisuke pulls the top rope and launches himself on top of Declan Deadeye. Demetrius grabs Eisuke and tries to send him into the steel steps, but Eisuke reverses and sends Demetrius into the same stairs! Ulysses runs up behind and shoves Eisuke into the steel pole at ringside. Eisuke's head begins to bleed. Ulysses gets Eisuke back in the ring. Ulysses stomps on Eisuke. The cameras zoom in and show the blood coming off Eisuke's face. Ulysses hits several clotheslines, piledriver and then a pump handle slam. With a sleeper hold on, Eisuke starts to fade. Only gets 2 counts. Eisuke gets the advantage back with his own sleeper hold. Ulysses drops down to hit a jawbreaker on Eisuke. Both men rise and trade hard punches. Eisuke hits several punches and then a spinning heal kick. Then Eisuke hits a reverse DDT on Ulysses to get a long 2 count. Eisuke goes for a huricanrana, but Ulysses drops him with a powerbomb! 2 Count! Ulysses tosses Eisuke off the ropes, misses a clothesline, and Eisuke strikes Ulysses jaw with a superkick! Both men lay out for almost 20 seconds. Eisuke covers, 2 Count. Ulysses pulls at Eisuke's tights which sends him outside the ring. Ulysses distracts the ref as Declan and Demetrius toss Eisuke into the steel steps and ring apron. Declan tosses Eisuke back in. The ref sees this and after a few seconds the ref tosses both Deadeye brothers. The fans cheer as the two men complain. As Declan and Demitrious walk up the ramp, Raghu and Suradet and Dimitri jump the Deadeye brothers. The fight spills into the back. Ulysses yells at his brothers halfway up the entranceway. At this moment, the ref is at an 8 count! Ulysses sprints back and dives back in to avoid the 10 count. Currently, Eisuke springboards off the second ropes and hits a spinning DDT on Ulysses! The fans erupt as Eisuke smiles big and rubs his blood across his body. He covers Ulysses ... 1, 2, NO!!! Ulysses kicks out. Eisuke attempts a move off the top rope, but Ulysses blocks it. Ulysses then hits a Superplex from the top rope. Ulysses gets a 2 count. Mad at the ref, Ulysses grabs the ref by the collar. Eisuke comes running in and hits a big boot on the ref in the corner as Ulysses moves at the last minute. Eisuke tends to the ref as Ulysses grabs a steel chair. As Eisuke turns, Ulysses blasts Eisuke in the face with the steel chair! Ulysses then opens the chair and hits a trop toe hold on Eisuke whose face smacks the chair. With the ref still sown, Ulysses hits an Atomic Leg Drop on Eisuke with the chair on Eisuke's face! This hurts Ulysses as well. He then shakes the ref awake. Ulysses covers, 1....2....NO! Eisuke smiles as his shoulder shoots off the mat! The fans cheer and chant N-P-L repeatedly! Ulysses doesn't know what to do. Ulysses stands and then out of nowhere Dane "The Dragon" Kealoha comes flying in off the top rope and hits a hurricanrana! He then starts punching Ulysses repeatedly. Once Ulysses stands, Dane grabs the chair, tosses at Ulysses. Deadeye catches it and Dane hits a spinning kick to the chair! This smacks Ulysses in the face with the chair. Dane pulls Eisuke on top of and out Ulysses. Dane then wakes up the ref and escapes through the crowd. The ref comes over and counts 1....2.... No!!! The ref is pulled out of the ring by Jaxtyn Anderson! He picks up Eisuke and hits a "MicDrop" on Eisuke. Jaxtyn then puts Ulysses on top of Eisuke. Jaxtyn tosses the ref in. The ref counts, 1....2....3! Ulysses Deadeye wins the Tournament and is the NEW #1 Contender for the NPL World Heavyweight Championship!!!)

Jim: So many double crosses and feuds intersecting in this ONE MATCH!

<u>Bob:</u> Obviously the Deadeyes try and help Ulysses. They get tossed from the match. Jake Duval's men take exception to the Deadeye's interference. Then Dane out of nowhere tries to cost Ulysses the match cause of the bad blood there. Finally...

<u>Juice:</u> Jaxtyn gets HIS revenge on Eisuke for costing him a shot at the NPL World Heavyweight Championship at Holy Grail 4! Flashback is a "Run it back" PPV that concludes rivalries. But after this match there are several feuds STILL in the works.

<u>Bob:</u> You keep interrupting me kid and we're going to feud.

<u>Jim:</u> Alright boys, we want to thank Asking Alexandria for performing for us tonight. Their tour is ongoing here in 2024. Check their website for tour dates.

(Cameras cut to the back were, the "Texas Outlaw" Duke Ken Jr walks into the arena. NPL Interviewer Katie Ouinn walks up to Duke and speaks.)

<u>Katie Quinn:</u> Excuse me Duke. Do you have a second? Looks like you just made it to the arena. So you are just now hearing that Ulysses Deadeye has won the #1 Contender's match to face you in the Main Event tonight. How do you feel about facing Ulysses Deadeye tonight?

<u>Duke Ken Jr:</u> (*Pauses*) I guess I have the advantage since he's already been through hell to get a shot at the "Texas Outlaw". Katie, I'm a 2-time NPL World Heavyweight Champion. I've faced and beat the best in this league. This title proves it. I hear the rumors about "I don't win clean. I don't lose clean". Tonight, I put those rumors to bed. Tonight...the title stays with me. Excuse me, Katie. (*Before he walks away...*) That's a pretty dress you have on... (*Katie smiles and the cameras cut back to ringside.*)

<u>Aldo:</u> Our next match is for the NPL Tag Team Championships!!! (Fans cheer) The match is set for one fall. Introducing first, the challengers...Koal and Karrion Killswitch!!!

(A loud and dynamic song pop over the PA system. Some fans cheer and boo as the Killswitch team walks through the curtain. Both men look into the camera with a stern look on their faces. Dressed in black and with a focused look on their face, Koal and Karrion shoot into the ring and pose to the crowd.)

<u>Aldo:</u> And their opponents, they are the NPL Tag Team Champions...Big S and Ford C...they are the Mud Diggers!!!

(Big S and C Ford come through the curtain. The fans cheer as the two men walks down the entranceway. Both titles around each men's waist. Big S and Ford C fist bump and enter the ring. They jump to the second ropes and pose for the crowd. The fans snap their pictures and continue to cheer for the hot team. They surrender the tag titles. Big S and Koal Killswitch start the match. They start talking trash to each other. The two men trade punches until Koal gets the advantage with knee to the stomach. The fans begin to chant "Mud Diggers". Koal takes Big S down and grapples with him. Headlocks and reverse chin locks. Karrion tags himself in punching Big S's stomach. Off the ropes Big S hits, a flying shoulder to Karrion! Big S then tags in C Ford. The Mud Digger hits a flying dropkick as Karrion came off the ropes. Ford only gets a 1 count. Big S tags in. Karrion then attacks Big S with vicious kick boxing kicks to the legs and stomach. Karrion then tosses Big S outside the ring. Koal is then tagged in. Big S dives back in to get a hard clothesline from Koal Killswitch! Koal tries to hip toss Big S, but S wasn't having it. He reverses and hits a neck breaker on Koal! Karrion runs at Big S who catches and in one motion powerslams Karrion hard to the mat. The ring shakes. The fans cheer as the Big S gets a 2 count on Koal. Big S tags in Ford. The momentum switches when Koal reverses a suplex and hits a side slam. Koal tags in Karrion. They then hit a flap double flapjack on Ford. Big S comes in and clotheslines Karrion over the top rope. This leaves Koal and Ford in the ring together. Ford hit a running back elbow. Big S and Karrion battle outside the ring until Karrion smash Big S off the barricade. Karrion gets on the apron and gets the tag from Koal. Karrion splashes Ford in the corner. As he turns around Big S is right there to annihilate Karrion with a hard clothesline. The Mud Diggers then hit several double team moves. They cut off the ring from Koal who awaits the tag from his partner. Ford pins Karrion and gets a 2 count. Ford hits a few snap suplexes and a German suplex and only gets a 2 count. Ford tags in Big S who hits a Samoan Drop on Karrion. Koal is yelling for a tag. Big S puts on a frond headlock. The fans start to get behind the Killswitch team and want the hot tag. Karrion gets out of the hold and back drops Big S. Seconds later the tag is finally made. Like a house of fire, Koal drops both Mud Diggers with drop kicks, back elbow and super kick to Big S. Legal man Ford gets hit with a side suplex. Koal then hits a standing moonsault and gets a long 2 count. Koal tries to hit a elbow off the ropes, but Big S grabs his feet. Ford runs at Koal and gets back dropped onto Big S outside the ring. As they get up, Koal runs over, springboards to the top rope and splashes on both Mud Diggers on the outside. The fans go nuts! Back in the ring moments later, Koal goes to make the tag, but Big S pulls him off the apron. This allows Ford to chop block Koal down. The Mud Diggers hit an impressive double underhook DDT that is turned into a German Suplex! The fans chant "This is awesome" repeatedly. Big S then gets Koal on the turnbuckle and hits a T-Bone Suplex from the top rope. Ford tags in and hits a frog splash on Koal. Ref counts 1, 2, NO! A frustrated Ford locks on a leg grapevine! Koal gets to the ropes. Ford doesn't break. Out of nowhere Karrion hits a flying headbutt!! The hold breaks, Moments later Koal gets the tag. Karrion picks Ford up and tosses him at Big S who slouches in the corner. Karrion then runs and splashes both men! Karrion hits a bulldog on Big S. Ford runs up and gets hit with a released fisherman's suplex! Koal now up. This allows the Killswitch boys to hit a spinebuster/blockbuster combo! Covers, 1, 2, NO! Big S interrupts the count. All 4 men get up stumble up and trade punches. Big S gets the better of Koal. Karrion gets the better of Ford. This leaves Karrion and Big S trading punches. They bounce off the ropes and double clothesline each other. Soon after, Karrion spears Big S in the ring. Karrion then dives through the ropes taking out C Ford. This leaves Koal on the top rope. He then hits a hard Frog Splash on Big S! The ref covers, 1, 2, 3! Koal and Karrion Killswitch win the NPL Tag Team Championships!!!)

Aldo: The winners of the match and NEW NPL Tag Team Champions...Koal and Karrion Killswitch!!!

<u>Jim:</u> My God! What a match! These two teams gave it all they had. What a hell of a way end the match, Juice!

Juice: It's early, but I'm saying it now...that was Match of the Year! Not night, Year!

Bob: Calm down Juicy. These 4 men put on a hell of a match. Listen to these people. It's loud in here!

(Koal and Karrion Killswitch raise their newly won NPL Tag Team Championships in the air. Sweat running down their faces, they celebrate up the ramp. Meanwhile, the Mud Diggers pick themselves up and embrace. The fans cheer for the Mud Diggers as they are greeted at the front of the entranceway by Quinn (Legend Reborn).)

(Cameras cut to a pre-taped Merchandise commercial. Katie Quinn and Juice Robinson are there selling assortment like; Dane "The Dragon" Kealoha's fire breathing stuffed plushy Dragon, "Texas Outlaw" Duke Ken Jr's Stetson and Outlaw leather vest cut, "The Arch Villian" Marcus Scurll's plague mask and umbrella, Deadeye Family T-Shirts, Hounds of Justice shirt, Jake Duval's beer mug, Mud Digger's T-Shirt, T-Money's new T-Shirt, and many more! 25% off all merch during the hours of the show.

Commissioner Jaxx pops in and says, "Don't forget the Commissioner's Platinum Boss Chalice! Drink like you own it!" The promo ends and the cameras cut back to the announce team.)

<u>Bob:</u> Oh I have to get one of those limited edition Commissioner Jaxx platinum chalice. You think they'll save one for me? Guys save one for Bob...

Juice: (Shakes his head.) You're pathetic, bro.

(Bob takes his pencil and runs it over his throat and mouths "I will kill you"

<u>Jim:</u> Our next match is the Cage Match. This one is very personal. Cousins. Money. Jealousy. Power. And Betrayal. All motivations to fracture a family...

(A 2-minute promo airs of the debut of the Macks, Justice and Malcolm. Good times of money, clubs, and teamwork. All three men were close. Cousins by blood. Brothers in the NPL. "Malcolm wants MY spot! He wants my money, my club, my standing here in the NPL. This is MY HOUSE!" T-Money says. Malcolm then says, "T-Money is selfish. He's power hungry. He's abused Justice and me for the last time. At Flashback, I put T-Money down!" The promo ends and the cameras catch the steel cage getting lowered to the ring. As it comes down, the front piece by the entranceway starts to break as it comes down around the ring pole. The ring crew fixed it and it lowered like it is supposed to.)

<u>Aldo:</u> It is now time for the Steel Cage Match!!! (*Fans cheer!*) The only way to win is to pin your opponent or have him submit. Introducing first, Malcolm Mack!!!

(Malcolm Mack's new entrance song, "Get It All" by DecadeZ hits. The fans erupt out of their seats and yell for the new fan favorite. He smiles and struts to the ring. M&M chants repeat throughout Ford Field. Malcolm climbs to the top of the cage and hypes up the crowd. As he does this, "Long Live the Chief" by Jidenna hits. The cheers and good time turns to LOUD BOOS. T-Money comes out in all gold gear. Gold glitter and money drops from the ceiling. Fans grab it and show it to the cameras. T-Money looks into the camera and says, "I'm ending this fool and I'm rich so just keeping it 100. Money don't lie." His smile turns to anger as T-Money drops his gold necklace, glasses, and giant fur jacket. He climbs the cage. As he gets to the edge of the top of the cage, Malcolm meets him there. Malcolm suplexes T-Money on the

cage! He then punches T-Money repeatedly. The fans cheer as Malcolm fires up the crowd. This allows T to get the advantage. He spears Malcolm. Then he punches Malcolm. T-Money then smiles at the fans. They boo. T then hits a Death Valley Driver on Malcolm! This breaks a corner of the cage. T-Money sees this and in fear he shakes his head and climbs down the cage wall. A few moments later Malcolm starts to climb down too. Currently, T has a steel chair. He swings it and misses. In doing so, the chair strikes the cage. Malcolm hits a clothesline and then tosses T into the side of the cage. The match hasn't started yet. Malcolm smashes T into the barricade, cage, and announce table. T then hits a back elbow and climbs the cage to get away from Malcolm. 34 of the way up, Malcolm chases after T. They trade punches until moments later, Malcolm slaps on a sleeper. This isn't smart cause as T fades, he loosens his grip and both men fall through the announcer's table! Malcolm gets the worst of it. As T gets up and then fireman's carries Malcolm into the cage/ring. Before he enters, T-Money pulls out the famous lead pipe. He smiles and tosses it in. T shuts the door. The match begins. T picks up the lead pipe and begins talking trash to Malcolm. He muffs his face and then strikes Malcolm in the back with the pipe. Malcolm screams! T repeatedly hits Malcolm. T tosses Malcolm into the steel cage. Over and over. He then hits Malcolm over the head with the pipe. The ref tries to tell T to get rid of the pipe. T just smiles at the ref. The ref just shakes his head in frustration. T goes over to pin Malcolm, 1, 2, no. T pulls Malcolms shoulders and head off the mat. T-Money smiles and says, "No, no, no...he owes me more than that for destroying my club!" This allows Malcolm to get the momentum as he grabs the pipe. In one quick move, Malcolm has T-Money in the cross face with the pipe in T's mouth. Malcolm viciously pulls back. The fans are cheering loudly for T to tap out! 30 seconds go by as T gets the ropes. The ref tells him it's No Disqualifications. T-Money is a strong guy, so he powers out. Malcolm charges with the pipe but gets speared! T gets up and grabs his jaw. Malcolm rolls around the ring grabbing his ribs. T-Money then signals for the "Hail Mary". A release Powerbomb. He sets him up and tosses Malcolm back into the wall of the cage! The fans groan. T-Money pulls Malcolm over again. He hits another Hail Mary on the other wall of the steel cage. Malcolm is lying in pain. T-Money throws his arms up and says, "This is all you have Malcolm? You're worthless." T-Money then goes for a 3rd Hail Mary on the next door, but Malcolm drops and hits a low blow on T-Money! The fans cheer. While T is squirming on the mat. Malcolm winces as he picks up the lead pipe slowly. The fans cheer this too. Malcolm then beats on T-Money with the pipe. T-Money yells in pain. Malcolm then tosses the lead pipe. Malcolm then hits a Death Valley Driver of his own. Malcolm, grabbing his ribs, calls for Money Made. He climbs to the top rope and dives off. He hits it (Big Splash). This sends Malcolm flopping all over the ring. He raises to all fours and starts spitting blood. As he stands, T-Money spears Malcolm through the ropes and the cage wall breaks! Both men spill out to the floor. The fans go nuts about this. After a long 90 seconds. T pulls the rest of the cage wall away! His strength impresses the announcers and fans in the arena. T then tosses Malcolm in the ring. He hits a Gorilla Press Slam and several Gut Busters on Malcolm. T pulls Malcolm by his hair as the camera zooms in to hear T say... "Your (Bleep!) mother would be disappointed at you!". Malcolm then grabs T-Money's eyes and rakes them. Struggling to stand, Malcolm hits a jumping knee to T. This allows Malcolm to hit a neck breaker on T. Both men are laying out. After a few seconds, you see Justice Mack come down the ring with a chair. He stands in the middle of the two men. Justice struggles with the chair. Facing T-Money the fans cheer. He pulls back and then in one quick moment, Justice smacks Malcolm on the head with the chair. The shot was so hard it bent the seat of the chair. T-Money then stands up and smiles. He hugs Justice and laughs. Justice looks in shock. Then suddenly Justice smashes T-Money with the SAME chair!!! The fans groan and grow quiet. Justice slams the chair down and the boos from the crowd fill

Ford Field. He then takes the lead pipe. Justice goes over to Aldo Montoya, takes his mic, and shoves him down. Justice speaks.)

<u>Justice Mack:</u> Shut the hell up Detroit! (*Fans Boo*) I'm tired of being in the middle of these fools! All my life I looked after Malcolm. Fought ALL his battles for him. Took care of him. I'm done. As for T-Money. Hey! T you are unconscious, but when you wake...I'M THE ONE THAT DESTROYED THE CLUB, homie!!! I stole the Micheal Jordan basketball. Bought me a new ride with it. But that's the point. It's all about money with you fools. I have the power now! Justice Mack is the future of this League. Not you T and definitely not you baby brother! This match is over.

(Justice slides back in the ring. The ref yells at Justice. He smiles at the ref and tosses the ref into the steel cage. Justice then bashes Malcolm in the stomach more with the pipe. Then once in the face. T-Money stumbles up and is hit with "Hard Justice". Justice is cold faced now. Rags2Riches Security comes down and escorts Justice out of the building by handcuffing him away.)

<u>Bob:</u> I thought T-Money was bad. I have never seen a more selfish and vindictive act in all my 30+ years in the wrestling business. And they are family!

Juice: Disgusting to say the least...

<u>Jim:</u> Never would I of though Justice would have been capable of this. The match was already intense enough. Medical personnel are in the ring helping these men onto a gurney.

Juice: Malcolm could have busted ribs, internal bleeding, and T...

<u>Bob:</u> Who cares! T-Money is scum. His family is all scum...well Malcolm is turning a corner, but T and Justice shouldn't be in the NPL if you ask me. But hey, it's not my company.

Jim: Thank God for that. Let's go to the back Katie Quinn is with our Commissioner Jaxx.

(Cameras cut to the back where Katie is speaking to Jaxx.)

<u>Katie:</u> I'm with National Patriots League Commissioner Jaxx to get a word from him on tonight's events. Commissioner it's been a wild night. What's the status of Justice after his actions tonight?

<u>Jaxx:</u> Katie I'm blown away by what just happened. I never would have thought this would happen. I have some tough decisions to make. That will happen in due time...

(Jake Duval enters the picture to speak to the Commissioner. Jaxx takes his shades off and looks at Jake with patience.)

<u>Jake:</u> Enjoying your night Commissioner? (Short pause) Well I'm Not! You changed your participants in our 6-Man Match, and did you see that neanderthal San La Muerte attack Jun-ho Mok backstage?! I saw the dead in his eyes. He should be 6 feet under! In a coffin! So, what are YOU Going to do about this?

<u>Jaxx:</u> We have a little PPV taking place in Arizona during the month of July, Boiling Point. You mention...coffin. I see no alternative than to have Jun-ho Mok take on San La Muerte in a Casket Match!

<u>Jake:</u> You didn't win tonight. I want a rematch. You'll give me this league, all I have to do is wait you out, Commissioner. An Asian League this will be.

Jaxx: (Gets in Jake's face.) Over my dead body Sweet Boy...

(Jake leaves and Jaxx speaks to Quinn.)

Jaxx: You were saying...

<u>Katie:</u> I...that's a huge announcement. Do you...

(Jaxx gestures for the Mud Diggers to come over. Big S and C. Ford enter the camera shot with ice on their necks and shoulders.)

Jaxx: Mud Diggers, that match was beyond impressive, fam.

Both: Thank You...

<u>Jaxx:</u> I think that match is what the NPL is all about. Let's run it back. The Killswitch guys Vs the Mud Diggers one more time. What do you say boys?

(Both men shake their heads yes and then shake Jaxx's hand. The fans cheer "one more time" repeatedly. Jaxx smiles as the Mud Diggers leave the shot.)

Katie: Back to you guys at ringside.

(Cameras cut back to the commentary team.)

Bob: Did he just say Casket Match?

<u>Juice:</u> Tag Team Championship Match Run It Back? One More Time! One More Time! (Fans continue to chant "one more time"!)

<u>Jim:</u> You have to love our commissioner. Boiling Point in Arizona is going to be a hot show. No pun intended. Let's switch gears and talk about the NPL All-American Championship Triple Threat Match. The Dominating Gaspar Mohammadi systematically destroyed NPL Legend Huxley Anderson to become NPL All-American Champion. The Anderson Brothers, Karsyn Anderson took a real exception to this.

Bob: Right. He went to commissioner Jaxx and demanded he get Mohammadi here at Flashback. The wild card in this is the former League champion Ambrose. See he won a huge match at Holy Grail that made him the #1 Contender for the NPL All-American Championship.

<u>Juice</u>: Now here we are. 3 men wanting to be champion. But I'm positive Karsyn just wants revenge. He said as much to me earlier. So, let's get this one started. Aldo... (Cameras cut to Aldo in the ring.)

<u>Aldo:</u> Our next match is a Triple Threat Match for the National Patriots League All-American Championship!!! *(Fans Cheer)* The rules are simple...No Disqualification, pinfall or submission is the only way to win. Introducing first representing the Hounds of Justice he is Ambrose!!!

(The cameras cut to the crowd where you see Ambrose dressed in thicker and bulkier riot gear. He gets over the apron and climbs through the ropes. He rips off the helmet and looks focused. A smirk comes from him as Gaspar's music hits. The fans boo.)

Aldo: And the champion, Gaspar Mohammadi!!!

(Fans boo as the large but confident man comes through the curtain. He looks at the crowd in disgust and slowly walks. As he gets halfway down the ramp, the cameras catch Karsyn Anderson dive from the ring barrier and onto Gaspar. Karsyn pummels Gaspar. Once up Karsyn sends Gaspar into the barricade and then hits a hard suplex on the entranceway! After a few seconds Karsyn starts to pull Gaspar towards the ring. Suddenly Ambrose launches himself through the 2nd and top rope colliding with both men! Ambrose then tosses Karsyn into the steel steps. Then he grabs Mohammadi and split legs him on the barricade. Ambrose then makes fun of Gaspar's pain. He then clotheslines him into the crowd. Ambrose attacks Gaspar through the crowd. The champion then gets the advantage with a poke to the eyes. Gaspar and Ambrose are in the hallway of the arena. Fans being pushed back by Rags2Riches Security. Gaspar is then struck with a piece of random lumber and then tossed into a road case. Ambrose grabs a fan's beer, drinks some and then spits it on Gaspar. This enrages Gaspar who picks Ambrose up and takes the two men through a stack of metal pipes. They all fall and clang to the ground. Ambrose starts to crawl back around to another hallway. This one leads to the fans again. Gaspar picks up Ambrose in a Gorilla Press Slam. He yells and then tosses Ambrose off the safety pole and then the Hound falls on several fans. The fans help Ambrose up and the two men make their way to the ringside. Once there, Karsyn blasts Gaspar with a steel chair! The sound echoes throughout the arena. Karsyn jumps the barricade and drags Gaspar to an equipment area. The two men brawl on an elevated area. Karsyn punches Gaspar multiple times and just as Gaspar starts to fall. Karsyn runs at Gaspar, and in one quick move Gaspar tosses Karsyn on his shoulder. In seconds Gaspar leaps down and powerslams Karsyn and himself through two tables down below!!! The fans go nuts! As time goes by Ambrose grabs Karsyn to the barricade. Karsyn shoves Ambrose off and goes back for Gaspar. Ambrose forearm smashes Karsyn in the back of the head. Ambrose gets Karsyn in the ring and the match finally starts. The next 4 minutes both Ambrose and Karsyn exchange high impact moves. After two near pinfalls, Gaspar slides in and hits a double clothesline! He hits a German Suplex on Ambrose and then hits a Double Underhook Backbreaker to Karsyn. Gaspar lifts Ambrose, but Ambrose slaps Gaspar. This makes the large man smile. He then knees Ambrose and hits a running powerbomb on Ambrose! Only gets a 2 count. Karsyn then flys out of nowhere and connects with a knee to the face. Gaspar stumbles. Karsyn hits a bunch of kicks to Gaspar's knee. Karsyn works on Gaspar's knee. Leg grapevines, and half crab on Gaspar. In pain Gaspar pushes up and gets out of the hold. Karsyn's momentum bumps into Ambrose. The Hound catches the top and 2nd rope, rebounds, misses the clothesline on Karsyn and hits it on Gaspar. Karsyn gets hit with a neck breaker. Ambrose stands and Detroit cheers in appreciation of the match. Ambrose goes under the ring to find...tables. The fans erupt. Ambrose tosses two tables in. He sets up one in the corner. The other Ambrose sits up in the middle of the ring. Gaspar now up powers Ambrose into the opposite corner. He bashes his shoulder into Ambrose's stomach. Gaspar tries to hit a German Suplex, but Karsyn blocks that. The Anderson brothers and Hound team up on the big Gaspar. They look at each other and then Gaspar is placed on Ambrose shoulders. They hit a double powerbomb on Gaspar through the table. The two men high five. The fans cheer. Ambrose then tosses Karsyn out of the ring. Ambrose covers Gaspar, 1, 2, no! Ambrose pulls Gaspar into the corner. After a few chops, Karsyn interrupts. Both men trade strikes. Gaspar runs at both men, as he does Ambrose pulls Karsyn in the line of Gaspar's crossbody. Gaspar hits that on Karsyn and both men go through the table. Ambrose slides out of the ring and gets a barbwire bat from under the ring. He waits until Gaspar gets up. Ambrose swings the bat and Gaspar catches it in his large right hand. Ambrose and Detroit are in shock. Gaspar pulls it out of his hand and blasts Ambrose with it. Blood drips from Ambrose's head and Gaspar's hand was bloody too. Both are outside the ring. Gaspar then punches Ambrose's head. He then hip tossed Ambrose on the ring steps. Ambrose screams

and flops around. Gaspar then hits a German Suplex on the floor on Ambrose. Gaspar chirps at the fans. He sees Karsyn crawl out of the broken wood pieces. He smiles and kicks Karsyn's head in disrespect. Gaspar grabs Karsyn's head and yells at him. Karsyn slaps Gaspar. Karsyn stands and fights back. Karsyn hits a sling blade. Then a vicious DDT. He got a 2 count. Karsyn goes to get a kendo stick out from under the ring. As he gets it, Hounds of Justice Reigns and Rollins attack Karsyn. Tossing him into the barricade. Reigns and Rollins then go after Gaspar. Rollins hits a "Stomp" and then Reigns hits a "Spear" on Gaspar! The fans cheer for this. Ambrose comes in and asks for a Triple Powerbomb. They hit it! Suddenly Karsyn slides in with his kendo stick and blasts all 3 members of the Hounds. Gaspar tries to stand; Karsyn then beats on Gaspar 12 times with the Kendo stick! The fans cheer! The camera zooms in to show pieces all over the ring. Karsyn goes for a finisher, but Gaspar reverses with a jawbreaker. Gaspar reaches into his tights for some powder. Gaspar tosses the powder; Karsyn ducks and the powder goes into Ambrose's eyes. Gaspar clotheslines Ambrose out of the ring. As Gaspar turns around, Karsyn hits a "Mic-Check" on Gaspar. The ref counts, 1, 2, NO! Gaspar kicks out. Karsyn goes to gets a steel chair. He swings and Gaspar punches the chair. Gaspar clinches his hand. This allows Karsyn to hit another "Mic-Check". The ref counts, 1, 2, 3! Karsyn wins the NPL All-American Championship!)

(Jaxtyn and Huxley sprint to the ring and lift up Karsyn who hold the NEW NPL All-American Championship! The fans cheer loudly. The Hounds pick up a prone Ambrose and escape through the crowd. The Andersons celebrate up the entranceway. The cameras cut to the back.)

(Cameras cut to Duke Ken Jr getting ready for his match. In deep thought he looks at the NPL World Heavyweight Championship. He kisses it and walks out of his locker room. The cameras then cut to Ulysses who walks down the hallway with Declan and Demitrious. Suddenly, Dane "The Dragon" Kealoha leaps onto Ulysses. Declan and Demitrius pull him off and slam Dane into a concrete wall. They punch and stomp Dane. Security comes in and breaks it all up. Ulysses is told to head to the ring. The Main Event is next.)

<u>Aldo:</u> It is now time for the Main Event!!! It is for the National Patriots League World Heavyweight Championship Match!!! (Fans Cheer) Introducing the challenger...Ulysses Deadeye!!!

(Ulysses music hits and he walk out the curtain. The fans give a mixed reaction. He gestures to the crowd that he's going to be champ. He enters the ring and slouches in the ring corner. After a long pause, "Some Kind of Monster" hits!)

<u>Aldo:</u> And now his opponent...the NPL World Heavyweight Champion, the "Texas Outlaw" Duke Ken Jr!!!

(After a long pause, Duke Ken Jr shoots out of the curtain. The fans get loud. He stops at the top of the entrance and smiles. Dressed in his tights pants, expensive leather vest, Stetson, and the Heavyweight Title shining around his waist. He fives the fans at ringside. He then gives his Stetson off to a young cancer survivor kid. They embrace and Duke stands on the apron. The fans continue to cheer. He climbs the 2nd turnbuckle and the fans cheer more. Duke and Ulysses lock eyes. The ref holds up the NPL World Heavyweight Championship. The bell rings. Duke stands in the middle of the ring. He's mouthing at Ulysses who still sits in the corner. Moments later, Ulysses pulls himself up and gets in Duke's face. Seconds later, Ulysses pushes Duke. Ken then pushes Ulysses back. They lock up and Duke is backed into the corner. Ulysses then pushes Duke's head. Duke charges Ulysses. The Deadeye slides out the ring.

Duke follows and Ulysses slides back into the ring. Duke follows and gets elbowed and stomped. Ulysses sends Duke off the ropes, hits a drop toe hold and then elbow to Duke's head. The champion stumbles to the corner. Ulysses tries to chop Duke, but Duke ducks. Duke then chops Ulysses hard. After the 3rd chop, Duke sends Ulysses into the opposite turnbuckle so hard, Ulysses bounces off and then flops on the mat in pain. Duke tosses Ulysses off the ropes and hits a Lou Thes Press on Ulysses. After several punches, he hits and elbow on Ulysses. Only gets a 1 count. Ulysses gets the advantage and hits a Russian Leg Sweep. He slaps a sleeper hold on from there. The fans get behind Duke as he reverses the move into a backbreaker. Duke then comes off the 2nd rope and hits an elbow on Ulysses. 2 count only. Ulysses backs up and pulls Duke through the ropes and the champ spills to the floor. Ulysses slams Duke's face on the edge of the ring and announce table. Ulysses hits Duke with a spikes DDT on the outside of the ring. Duke is out. Ulysses tries to put him in the ring, but Duke is dead weight. The ref comes over to check on him. Duke speaks to the ref. But the ref tries to hold up X. Duke pulls his arms down and stumbles up to his feet. The ref tries to stop him. Duke grabs bottled water and spills it over the Texas Outlaw's head. Ulysses goes after Duke's head now. The champion is not moving the same. Duke is standing on the floor and Ulysses tries to run at Duke while on the apron. Ulysses tries to kick, but Duke superkicks Ulysses feet out from under him. Ulysses face plants the apron. Duke pulls Ulysses' legs to the ring pole and pulls back causing Ulysses manhood to split the ring pole. Duke slides in and hits a snap suplex. Moving slowly, Duke covers. 1, 2, no. Ulysses gets the advantage and abuses Duke in the corner with kicks and chokes. The ref pulls Ulysses off. Ulysses then applies a sleeper hold. The fans got behind Duke again. Duke hits a jawbreaker. Duke sends Ulysses off the ropes and Ulysses hits a spinning heel kick on Duke. Ulysses punches Duke's head. Ulysses then hits a slow neck breaker on Duke. Covers, 1, 2, No! Duke barely shoots his shoulder up. Ulysses knees Duke's neck and then applies a leg grapevine around Duke's neck. Tightly squeezing Duke's head. The ref checks and Duke pulls Ulysses legs back for a quick cover, 1, 2, no. Both up, Ulysses hits a stiff back elbow! Duke's head bounces off the mat. Ulysses pulls his hair back and brushes his shoulder off. Ulysses slowly walks over to Duke who shoots up and hits several clotheslines on Ulysses. Off the ropes Duke hits a flying lariat. Duke then gets his second wind. He hits a spinebuster. Gets a 2 count. Duke holds his head. After Duke chops Ulysses multiple times, Duke Irish whips Ulysses to the opposite corner. Duke runs in and Ulysses kicks Duke in the face. Ulysses then hits a backstabber on Duke! Ulysses only gets a 2 count. Deadeye complains to the ref. Ulysses then tries to hit a stunner on Duke. But Duke reverses it into a Fisherman's Suplex. Covers, 1, 2, no! As both men slowly get up, Ulysses hits an enzuigiri on Duke. Bouncing off the ropes, Duke hits a violent clothesline that turns Ulysses inside out. Duke then calls for the "Whiskey in a Jar" (Stunner). As he gets close to Ulysses, the Deadeye hits a quick superkick!!! The fans cheer the move. Ulysses covers 1, 2, No! Duke kicks out. The fans cheer N-P-L repeatedly. Ulysses then tries a move, but Duke reverses. This is then reversed as Ulysses hits a devastating brain buster on Duke. Both men are down and exhausted. Moments later, both men are up and trading punches. Ulysses hits a bicycle kick to Duke. Ken then bounces off the ropes and hits a Pele kick. But Ulysses falls on Duke for the pin. 1, 2, NO! Both men lay on the mat. The fans then chant "Fight Forever" repeatedly. As both men stand, they begin yelling at each other. Duke runs and Ulysses kicks Duke in the stomach, Texas Outlaw falls to his knees. Ulysses hopes off the 2nd rope to attempt a Canadian Destroyer, but Duke tosses Ulysses on his shoulders. Ulysses reverses that into a shoulder breaker! Cover, 1, 2, No! Duke kicks out again! Ulysses is in shock. Ulysses then stands over Duke talking trash to Duke... "I'm the Coward? Huh?! Look at you. You are beat!" Ulysses comes off the ropes and Duke hits a quick power slam. Duke then waits for Ulysses to stand. As he does, Duke tries to hit a "Whiskey in a Jar", but Ulysses reverses and then tries to hit a Stunner of his own. Duke

blocks and pulls Ulysses off his feet. Duke applied the Texas Cloverleaf! The fans erupt. Ulysses yells in pain. After 20 seconds, Ulysses gets to the ropes. After a 4 count, Duke releases. Duke drops to his knees holding his head. The ref checks on him. Ulysses goes out to the ring apron. Duke comes over and is backdropped to the floor by Ulysses! Deadeye then tosses Duke in. At his knees Duke is struck in the back of the head with a vicious knee! Ulysses quickly covers, 1, 2, NO!!! Duke kicks out. Ulysses is irate now. He kicks the bottom rope and yells in the ref's face. The fans chant "This is awesome" repeatedly. Ulysses runs at Duke and clotheslines Ulysses! Both men down. Seconds later, Ulysses is up. The ref is checking on Duke. At this moment, Dane "The Dragon" Kealoha elbows Ulysses from the apron. Duke sprints over. Ulysses moves and Duke annihilates the Dragon off the apron. As Duke turns around, Ulysses hits a Stunner on Duke. Ulysses then covers Duke. 1, 2, 3! Ulysses Deadeye WINS!!!)

Aldo: Here is your winner and...NEW NPL World Heavyweight Champion...Ulysses Deadeye!!!

(Seconds later, Ulysses stands and snatches the title from the ref and raises it high. Demetrius and Declan are celebrating in the ring. The cameras cut to Duke who is up against the barricade in disbelief. Dane is on the outside against another barricade in disbelief as well. Duke stands with his hands on his waist. Ulysses drapes the title over the ropes, and the other Deadeyes surround Ulysses. He taunts Duke. Duke stands near the announcer's table. Dane comes over and tries to explain himself. Duke calmly mouths, "Why are you even out here? You know what...save it. This is your fight." Duke walks away in disgust. Dane points at the Deadeyes and yells at them. Cameras cut to the announcers.)

<u>Jim:</u> Who would have seen this coming? Ulysses Deadeye is the new NPL World Heavyweight Champion.

<u>Bob:</u> Duke is right. If Dane left it alone then Duke might have retained. The goody two shoes both fell on their face tonight.

<u>Juice</u>: How can you say that? Ulysses and the Deadeyes have been after Dane for weeks. Ulysses nearly cost Dane the match earlier. Nearly cost our commissioner that match. And now the Deadeyes have our League's biggest prize.

<u>Bob:</u> You're young Juice. So, let me explain something to you my naïve friend. Actions have consequences. If the hot-headed Dragon stayed in the back, then Maybe the champ would possibly be champion right now. But his choice led to the unfortunate consequence. (*Bob turns to the camera.*) Learn to let go Dragon. If you play with fire, then you get burned.

<u>Jim:</u> Bob, Duke Ken Jr could have won that match despite the inadvertent distraction. But give credit to Ulysses. He brought it tonight. He won two matches. He was hungry and now he's champion. How's it going to shake out with Dane, the Deadeyes, and is Duke going to want a rematch? So many more questions now. Next time we are on PPV we will be in Arizona. Boiling Point! For Bob, Juice, and myself so long from Detroit.

(Cameras catch up to Duke Ken Jr walking down the hallway. He is walking with his head down. He is obviously in a state of frustration. He then stops and the cameras pan over to reveal ... an injured "Arch Villian" Marcus Scurll. He speaks.)

<u>Marcus:</u> (Pauses and gives a beer to Duke.) Looks like you have a mountain to climb, brother. Well...the Texas Outlaw I know will get back on top again. It's just a matter of time. Now let's get some beers and party in Detroit!

<u>Duke:</u> (Finally smiles) Detroit won't know what hit them. Where to?

(Marcus puts his arm around his long-time buddy, they cling their beer bottles and drink as they leave the arena.)

PPV Ends with a video montage.
