(The show opens with a tour of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. Camera shots of all the legends in the business. The final shot shows the Alpha Males looking at Creedence Clearwater Revivals display. Fans on the TV broadcast cheer this. Then the cameras cut to finely dressed men in suits; NPL Color Commentators Bob Sapp & Juice Robinson, Play by Play guy Jim Jones AND Commissioner Jaxx are sitting at a FLASHBACK desk right in front of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. A large group of fans are there with their signs in the background cheering. Jim Jones now speaks...)

Jim Jones: On the eve of the spring Pay-Per View, Flashback...this is Frontline. Welcome to the show boys and girls all around the world as we welcome you to the holy grounds of Rock and Rolls Legends, the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. In Cleveland, OH. I am as you know, "The Voice of the NPL" Jim Jones. Joining me tonight is my partner in crime, the legend himself, Bob Sapp. My other partner who has just come off a tour of Nigeria. We'll get into that later. And our special guest at the desk tonight, Commissioner of the NPL, Mr. Jaxx. Welcome gentlemen.

Bob Sapp: I just want to start off by saying being here at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame is a real dream of mine. I grew up listening to guys like Chuck Berry, Buddy Holly, B.B. King, The Supremes, I could go on and on. To come here, take the tour and see all my legends in one place... *(sighs)*

Juice Robinson: You cried. It's okay to feel, Bobby.

Bob: (*Snaps back*) I did NOT cry! There may have been a bit of dust in the wind, and it entered my eyeballs. But I did not cry. I do have a mean right hand that I can introduce you to if you keep this up tonight...

Commissioner Jaxx: That won't be necessary. Bob I can second your...overcome with emotions...

Juice: (*Mumbles*) ...or crying...

Commissioner Jaxx: I get it Bob, grown men don't cry, but it isn't that. You have memories of where you were when you heard these artists play. We all have appreciation for music and what it did to help us grow up. I was more of an Al Green guy myself, but I digress. Tonight the National Patriots League is here to celebrate the music, but ALSO bring you a Battle Royal.

Juice: That's right Jaxx. And give you a look at all the matches the NPL will give you the fans for the 6th Annual FLASHBACK. With that, let's get to the first match...

<NPL ALL-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH>

Malcolm Mack

Vs

Justice Mack ©

w/Entourage & Lincoln Mack

Juice: Born brothers. They are now separated by greed, fame, betrayal, and maybe...vengeance? These two men were a tag team and running mates with The Big-Ticket T-Money. They separate from him and go their own paths. One man is loved by the fans. Maybe he smokes a little too much, but he has gone on to be one of the most OVER wrestlers in the NPL's history. The fans have deemed him "M&M". Malcolm is starved for NPL gold. But to get to that goal...he has to face his own brother again. Justice is a goal driven man. "All he does is win" as he says. Accompanied by his loyal "brother" Entourage. And...his estranged father Lincoln Mack. Who was in the corner of the younger Malcolm. M&M was betrayed by his father to join older sibling and NPL All-American Champion Justice Mack. These two have carried this feud for many months...it ends at Flashback...

Commissioner Jaxx: I have two brothers myself. I came up in the world just like both of these boys, so I can definitely relate. It isn't easy coming from nothing. Starving and living a life not knowing what tomorrow will bring. They both are ambitious. They both want to be the best here in the NPL. But when I heard Justice say he doesn't acknowledge Malcolm as his brother. Just another guy on the street...that is cold. And...

Bob: I'm sorry boss, but we all know that Justice was tired of carrying that anchor around his neck known as Malcolm. (*Fans boo this*) Like it or not people, but Justice is his own man now. He is here to hold titles and be remembered in the business. He really is the Future of the IWA and he shows it. If he's cleaning up Malcolm's messes all the time then he wont realize his own dreams. Malcolm is responsible for Malcolm now. He's a big boy. As for this "Betrayal" nonsense. Lincoln Mack, the father of Justice sees the ambition of his son and cut the dead weight as he should...

(The video package begins with a black and white texture and a brutal beating The Patriot: Ric Splatterhouse did to the then NPL World Heavyweight Champion, T-Money at Flashback 2025 Playas Club. With blood showing red while the video still shows back and white. Splatterhouse's destruction of T-Money and holding the title over his head as doctors place T-Money into an ambulance. Back to a colorful view...Splatterhouse defends his title against the returning Dane "The Dragon" Kealoha. The match was somewhat competitive. Splatterhouse was looking to hit his finish until T-Money comes in with a "Spear" and "Hail Mary". The Dragon finally becomes champion. Splatterhouse violently destroys backstage property. So SWAT tases him and hauls him away. This sets up a Devil's Playground Match at Hell on Earth. Then the camera cuts to them falling off a ledge by push from Man Mountain Meat. Splatterhouse eventually gets up and stumbles away. Fast Forward to Holy Grail 6. The Triple Threat Match to determine the #1 Contender for the NPL World Heavyweight Championship. The video shows the brutality of this match. In the end, Splatterhouse was ready to finish off T-Money, but the opportunist, Meat gets the victory. Then weeks leading up to Flashback 2026, T-Money sneak attacks Splatterhouse. Only for T-Money's car to be set on fire. The final parts of the video shows their final pull apart brawl and Splatterhouse pie-facing Commissioner Jaxx to get to T-Money. The song ends and both men are shown face to face...)

Jim: Well gentlemen here we are. Who wants to talk about this one first?

Commissioner Jaxx: I'll say this...I've seen an angry Splatterhouse. The man is a true monster. He can't be stopped. You saw what he did to me in that video package. What he did to you three at Flashback last year. I've known T-Money most if not all his life. He fears no man. I've seen T take on 3-4 men at once. He was my heavy for good reason because he is 3-4 men combined. This monster Splatterhouse can't be stopped. T-Money will have to go to a place deep and dark place to stop Splatterhouse. I was going to say I need to get an ambulance ready. But let's be honest gentlemen. This match is going to get ugly. At Flashback...this will be an Ambulance Match...

(All three men look at each other in shock...)

Juice: I can't say I'm surprised. It could even be poetic considering T-Money was hauled off in an ambulance last Flashback in his very own night club. Splatterhouse is a scary man. I don't think many can stop him here in the NPL. And after coming inches from his rage...I wouldn't want to be T...I don't see how T makes it through this. Splatterhouse wins.

Bob: *(Laughs)* This scumbag T-Money will FINALLY get what he has coming to him. Splatterhouse is the reaper and after Flashback is over, the "Big Ticket" will have to retire. *(Looks into the camera.)* Terrence...go on back to that night club of yours and be a business owner. Because a career in the wrestling business isn't for you. He has missed several months at the hands of Splatterhouse. Why do this to yourself? Splatterhouse will brutalize T-Money, again.

Jim: We have seen T-Money do some amazing things in the NPL's history. His winning percentage is the highest and he's been a former 2-Time NPL World Heavyweight Champion. I know you believe in him Commish, but I too have felt the wrath of Splatterhouse. He's too dominant for T-Money. Speaking of dominant. Let's talk about the NPL BEST Tag Team. Jaymz and Jonathan Dante defend their Tag Team Championships against the new team of Kraker and Rooster...

Juice: Like a broken record we have witnessed the best tag team in the NPL. Jaymz and Jonathan Dante have defeated teams like the Alpha Males, Killswitch Brother, the Anderson Family and the Soldiers of Freedom. No team is as decorated or dominant as they are. Rooster and Kraker have come into the league and landed on the front page on multiple occasions. As a team? Maybe they have beat a few teams. But there is no way these backwoods rednecks will defeat the great Dantes. Jaymz and Jonathan up! *(Fans Cheer)*

Commissioner Jaxx: I have to go the opposite way in this one Juicy. These “backwoods rednecks” as you call them are scrappy. Sure, the Dante Brothers have defeated a lot of teams, but are they complacent? We have seen...

Jim: Hold on a second commissioner. Sorry to cut you off, but we have a fight going down in the Rock in Roll Hall of Fame...guys can we get a look at this?

(Commissioner Jaxx jumps up and runs to the doors of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. Cameras cut to a camera man running through the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. Finally, he catches up to Kraker, Rooster, Backwoods Brawler, and Redneck Reaper brawling with the Alpha Males. The fans are surrounding the brawl and cheering. Displays are being knocked over. Commissioner Jaxx and 12 Rags2Riches Security guards break up the two brawling teams. The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame rep tells Jaxx to pay for the broken displays and to get these guys out of here. Jaxx calms down the rep and offers to pay for the damage. The cameras cut back to the Frontline Team.)

Jim: We're back? Okay. *(Fans still cheering.)* Yeah, guys that was intense. We saw the Alpha Males enjoying the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame earlier. How did this brawl take place? Oh...okay...looks like we have video of the events that transpired...

Juice: Looks like the Alphas are enjoying the exhibits. And...There! The 4 members of MMM. We can't hear what is being said but looks like there is a disagreement and NOW A BRAWL! And there is the commissioner. The MMM guys started this...

Bob: You guys say the Alphas are just enjoying their time at the show. How do we know they didn't start this fight, huh? All that damage to these exhibits too.

Jim: Here comes the commissioner...

Commissioner Jaxx: Unbelievable! This is going to cost me big. I don't care who started it. Since Kraker and Rooster want a piece of the Alphas? Well, the Alphas will now be in the Tag Team Championship Match at Flashback! It is a triple threat match now! *(Fans Cheer and chant N-P-L repeatedly.)*

Juice: *(Excited!)* Alright! This will add to the intrigue of the Tag Team Championship Match. The Alphas came very close to defeating the Dantes at Holy Grail 6. Now they get a second chance.

Bob: Now the deck is stacked on the Dantes!

Commissioner Jaxx: Don't worry, these two teams will be fined for this. So, this isn't a REAL reward to the challengers. As for the Dantes...when you are champions then you have to be ready at any time to defend your titles. No matter the challenge...

Jim: Well commissioner it's funny you say that because it's time to talk about the Main Event...

<NPL WORLD HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH>

Man Mountain Meat **Vs** **“Texas Outlaw” Duke Ken Jr** ©

Jim: This match is for the National Patriots League World Heavyweight Championship. The challenger Man Mountain Meat defeated both The Patriot Ric Splatterhouse and T-Money to be the #1 Contender. And earn a shot against the champion, “Texas Outlaw” Duke Ken Jr. Now commissioner...you got involved in this one and was nearly blasted with a steel chair after being struck with a microphone from Duke. I'm anxious to hear what you have to say about this match...

Commissioner Jaxx: All I was trying to do was talk sense into Duke. As I have tried to do his entire life. I may have...went too far and spoke about Duke Ken Sr. You three need to understand...I go way back with the Ken family. We had our disagreements and I might have acted out. But I made amends with them. I promised on Sr's deathbed that I would look after Junior. At one point, junior was on the right path. These fans loved him... (*Fans Boo*) I know, I know. He's lost, Jim. But I will say that he has the right version of himself to defeat Man Mountain Meat. The old Duke is very much gone. The boy I knew and helped raise is...

Bob: Sorry again boss, but this is the BEST version of Duke Ken Jr. He is a killer. (*Fans Boo*) He doesn't care about them. (*Fans Boo*) and he damn sure won't let anyone take that title without him taking a piece. Past relationships like yours don't matter. That little bandage on your forehead from the mic shot is just a taste of the violence Duke will bring in this match. We saw a promo package with the scumbag T-Money and Splatterhouse. The song was called “Gone” ...well you can call Duke gone. Respectfully...you need to be our commissioner Jaxx. Not Duke's father. (*Fans moan and Jaxx sits back in his chair.*)

Juice: Bob, that's too far. Man Mountain Meat is focused on winning that title. Duke is willing to do anything to retain. Including going after what we know you to be commissioner as family.

Commissioner Jaxx: (*Calmly.*) No, Juice. Bob is right. As commissioner I have to be better. I have tried to protect Duke a little too much. He's grown and successful by his own merits. He may be a vile man now, but he's got his hands full with Man Mountain Meat. Despite being struck by the mic...I have to go with Duke on this one. (*Fans Boo!*)

Bob: (*Smiling and proud.*) There it is. Yes Duke is our champion and named by you NPL's Best Wrestler of the first 100 Cycles. Great pick boss. (*Fans Boo*)

Juice: Listen to you both...Man Mountain Meat is unstoppable and is going to stop this tyrant reign of Duke's...Man Mountain Meat up. (*Fans Cheer*)

Jim: With that we want to thank the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame for hosting us. Sorry for the mess. Commissioner Jaxx will make that right. Please enjoy the Battle Royal taking place after this commercial...

*(The lights flicker in the background and a high-pitched noise sounds. All the commentators pull their earpieces out. A video plays and a message on the screen... **MaTty iS aLivE DID yOU ForGET???** Piece of paper is removed from the screen. A man's hands are tied up with rope with his arms above him. The man's hair is covering his face. Sweat and blood covering his body. There are bruises and cuts on his body. The Dark Figure appears from the right of the screen. His mask is revealing a LARGE smile. He points to the screen with a kendo stick and bashes the victim with the stick. The Dark Figure then picks up a taser and shocks the screaming man. A new piece of paper is put to the screen... **PaiN is The OnLY saLvaTIonnn...SEE YOU SOON!** The Dark Figure laughs manically in the background and he shines a flashlight in the face of the victim. The cameras reveal it to be Head Security Guard Matt!!! The feed cuts out as The Dark Figure waves at the video...)*

(Commissioner Jaxx throws his chair and slams his fists on the table. He straightens up his tie and gets himself together. He gets out his phone and speaks...)

Commissioner Jaxx: ...Detective Myers, please.

(Card 7: Held in Fort Worth, Tx. The show opens with the 10K+ fans cheering for NPL Frontline. A few seconds later, “Triumph of the King Freak” by Rob Zombie sounds. The Fort Worth crowd surprisingly cheers for the NPL World Heavyweight Champion. “The Arch Villain” Marcus Scurll and “Texas Outlaw” Duke Ken Jr step through the curtain. They look at each other with their own surprise to the Ft Worth crowd cheering. Some boos mixed in. Marcus is dressed in black jeans, a large overcoat, and holding his classic umbrella. Duke is in jeans, cowboy boots, flannel cut off shirt, hair in a bun, and the shiny World Heavyweight championship in his right arm. They walk to the ring and then enter. Marcus speaks first.)

Marcus: Fort Worth, Texas!!!! Welcome the hometown boy, the BEST wrestler in the NPL, the Standard around here, and the 3...4...I lost count. Heavyweight Champion of the World!!!! “Texas Outlaw” Duke Ken Jr!!! *(Fans give a mixed reaction as Marcus hands off the mic.)*

Duke: Finally. A city that gets it. Let me hear you, Ft Worth! *(Fans give another mixed reaction as Duke raises the World Title over his head.)* Frontline or PPV’s is the place where a champion will always be! I may be hated, but all I do is win! Texas made and Texas Proud, Duke Ken Jr’s family has run this part of the country’s wrestling business for multiple generations. Promoters set them up and we knock them down. It’s time we...

(“Rags2Riches” by Rod Wave sounds. The fans cheer as Commissioner Jaxx walks through the curtain. Dressed in a light blue suit, designer shades, and platinum cross around his neck. He walks to the ring and enters. Jaxx starts to speak, but Jaxx stops him.)

Marcus Scurll: Commissioner J...this better be good...

Commissioner Jaxx: Marcus...you are living on that doctor’s note for longer than you should. Speak again and I’ll give you and that umbrella tossed out of my building.

(Marcus’ face is in shock and tells Duke to tell him off. Duke tells Marcus to relax.)

Duke: I am surprised to see you here, Jackson.

Commissioner Jaxx: You shouldn’t be son. I own everything you see in the National Patriots League. *(Fans Cheer this)* The mics you speak into, the checks you cash, and the jell you put in that bun, champ. You are in this position because of me. I build all of this.

Duke: Thank you, sir. Thank you for setting the table. I made dinner. So, this is MY HOUSE, Jackson. BUT...continue old G. *(Fans groan.)* Tell all of us why you are really out here.

Commissioner Jaxx: Let's get one thing straight...you may cook the dinner, but I bought the groceries. *(Fans groan again.)* I actually have a lot to say. I have had a front row seat for your entire career. I have seen you wear that championship with honor. Defended against the toughest and best in this league. You might be a son of a *(Bleep!)* but a champion here, nonetheless. *(Fans groan.)* But I am really out here to talk about Flashback. The Main Event to be exact. And surprising as this is you will not like what your commissioner has to say. See you just spoke about your family. How your family put all they had into this business. Held all the championships. Must you forget, I was on the road with your dad. I saw the best of him...and the not so best of him. He may have been a good dad. I'll give him that. I respect him and your granddad. This may surprise you, but your dad NEVER wanted to be a father.

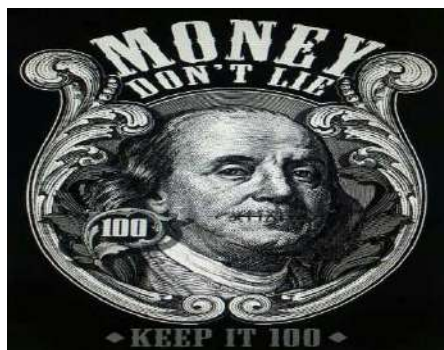
Duke: You don't know what you're talking about. My dad trained me, fed me, and taught me everything I know. It's funny you say all this since you never had children yourself... *(Fans groan.)*

Commissioner Jaxx: He would pawn you off on me any chance he got. Ask T-Money...he will tell you what I'm talking about. Your dad may have been present...but he couldn't stand you. See I was there to wipe your nose, give you kind words, cheer you up while you were down, and get you out of trouble. Duke Ken Sr could not be bothered. His career mattered more than his family... *(Fans groan)*

Duke: *(His face turns serious.)* Be careful what you say next...

Commissioner Jaxx: Look...you are a multigenerational talent in this business. Most would kill to be champion as many times as you have. You understand greatness. Life takes us down different paths, sure. At one point, I thought Duke Ken Jr would be the light, the white knight that these people love. But look at you. Running around with a toy no one wants to play with. I'm talking about you, Marcus. At one point I saw in you what I saw in your dad when I first met him. "That Duke Ken...man I want the life he has. Fast cars, ridding in limos, blowing money in the casino for fun, and having a family." That's the life I always said I wanted. At one point, you brought the good to this locker room at such a young age. I cannot take all the credit for the NPL's success. You also did that. *(Duke shakes his head and the fans cheer that.)* Something your dad couldn't do. Truth is...I did not want to give you this latest title match. But you used that ruthless streak to get what you want out of Jaymz Dante. But as for Flashback...you are facing a challenge like no other. Man Mountain Meat. *(Fans Boo.)* This man is serious. He shoved two men 15-20 feet off a ledge. He defeated BOTH T-Money and Ric Splatterhouse. Both former champions! This guy isn't in it to win championships. He just wants to watch the world burn. You can still win this match, but YOU HAVE TO be willing to watch the world burn too. Your father understood that more than anyone. Duke Ken Sr could match against any man or beast. Lately...you are not your dad. *(Fans moan loudly.)*

(Duke rolls his eyes and looks at Marcus. Then Duke strikes Jaxx with the mic! The fans' reaction is shocked but also turns to boos. Marcus looks on in shock as well. Duke tells Marcus to get him a chair. Marcus hesitates. Duke yells for a steel chair. Marcus begrudgingly gets one from under the ring. Duke tells Jaxx, "I warned you about talking about my father. You wanna see me burn it down?!" Duke pulls the chair from Marcus. Duke pulls it back and Man Mountain Meat's music hits. Meat dives in the ring and both Marcus and Duke attack Meat. They try to hit "Shatter Machine" on Meat, but he powers out and drops Marcus with a spinebuster! Duke smashes Meat with the chair! Meat turns and smiles at Duke. The champion dives out of the ring. Meat then hits the "Meat Sickle" on Marcus. Duke clutches his title as he leaves the arena through the Ft Worth crowd. Rags2Riches Security helps a dazed Commissioner Jaxx on the outside of the ring. Man Mountain meat climbs the 2nd rope and points at Duke. He gives the cutthroat gesture and then swipes his waist to say he is the next champion.



(Card 20: Held in Miami, Florida. The show has just come back from commercial. Then “Long Live the Chief” by Jidenna hits. The fans cheer as “The Big Ticket” T-Money walks through the curtain. Dressed in a black pants, T-Money merch shirt, and a huge grin on his face. He walks to the ring. He enters and grabs a mic. The fans continue to chant “Money” multiple times.)

T-Money: Money don’t lie and the Big Ticket ALWAYS Keeps it 100!!! *(Fans Cheer)* It’s been a minute since the Big Ticket has spoken to you all. Your boy picked the most beautiful place on earth. Great beaches and the clubs are where it’s at. Playas Club needs to branch out and come to Miami! *(Fans Cheer!)* Hey...you want it? Well then T will deliver! *(Fans Cheer.)* Money is out here to address that freak and nemesis of mine, Ric Splatterhouse. *(Fans give a mixed reaction.)* You have bullied plenty of dudes in this league. Maybe at one point yours truly could say that. One year ago, you put Money in the hospital. 8 months ago, T cost you the NPL World Heavyweight Championship to a guy who can’t stay healthy. The burned man and T have a war at Hell on Earth. Then SOMEONE sticks their ugly nose where it doesn’t belong. This feud is so strong that it distracts us both to the point that Man Mountain Meat... *(Fans Boo.)* Man Mountain Meat wins the triple threat by pinning Money. Now to present day! This war we got going Splatterhouse...it needs to end. You wanted a final match with T. Your boy is dressed to fight. *(Fans Cheer!)* You may be a monster, but T-Money can get vicious too. Splatterhouse!!! Get your extra crispy *(Bleep!)* down here right now!

(You hear Commissioner Jaxx’s voice on the mic. He comes down the ramp and stops at the head of the ring. % Rags2Riches Security members are with him.

Commissioner Jaxx: I’m sorry ladies and gentlemen that will not be happening tonight. *(Fans boo!)* Sorry Miami, be upset about this all you want. I am out here to make sure we get to Flashback and have the “One More Time” match. So please leave the ring T so the show can continue...

(The lights go out and fire shoots from the entranceway! The fans erupt from their seats. The Patriot Ric Splatterhouse’s music hits and out walks the monster. Slowly he walks. Rags2Riches Security tries to stop Splatterhouse, but he annihilates them with clotheslines. He then gorilla press slams one guard onto the other three. Commissioner Jaxx tells Splatterhouse to stop. Splatterhouse pie-faces Jaxx to the side. Splatterhouse climbs the ropes and the two men brawl. Commissioner Jaxx and 7 Miami police enter the ring. Both T and Splatterhouse pause. T yells at Jaxx and Splatterhouse. The officers have their tasers drawn on the monstrous Splatterhouse. The Patriot leaves the ring. He picks up the steel stairs and tosses them. Then he tumps over the announcer’s desk. The fans boo this. T is seen sliding out of the ring and he dives on Splatterhouse. They exchange punches. The officers taser both men. After a moment or two both men fall down. They then cuff both men. Stumbling to the back both men are placed in a swat type van. The door shuts. And all of a sudden, the van begins to shake. Both handcuff men are headbutting each other! The officers taser both men again and then pile in the back of the van as it quickly rides off.)



(Card 3: Held in Accra, Guana. On an international tour, Malcolm Mack faces Lightningboy Bobby Day. One night ago, Malcolm defeated Thrillbilly in Toledo, OH. The winner of this contest will be the #1 Contender for the All-American Championship and will face Justice Mack at the PPV known as Flashback during cycle #100. The match was a back-and-forth affair for 20+ minutes. At the 26-minute mark, Lightningboy tries to hit his finisher, but M&M reverses into an incredible sit down powerbomb! Malcolm then hits "Money Made" and covers, 1, 2, 3! Malcolm wins the match and is named the #1 Contender! As he holds his hands up, you see the All-American Champion Justice Mack attack Malcolm out of nowhere! Justice hits a blockbuster from the 2nd rope. Justice looks at the upset crowd and smiles. Malcolm slowly gets to his knees. So, Justice comes off the opposite ropes and hits a "shining wizard" to the back of Malcolm's head. The fans boo more. Malcolm lay unconscious. Entourage and Lincoln Mack enter the ring. Justice yells at them to hook him on the ropes. Both men do so. Justice gets his All-American Championship and gets close to Malcolm's face. The camera picks up Justice talking.)

Justice: No matter how hard I try...you WON'T GO AWAY!!! I have been sick of you our entire lives! Pathetic! You see this? You want this? *(Justice shoves the title in M&M's face.)* THIS is as close to the All-American Championship as you are EVER going to get!!!

(Justice stands on the other side of the ring. He looks at his title, to the crowd, and then at Malcolm. He runs over, but Lincoln steps in-between a prone Malcolm and Justice.
