**Katie:** I see a few new entrants since the last time this event was hyped a few cycles ago. Soldiers of Freedom #1, #2, #3, #4, and #5 were all added. These guys are muscular, in great wrestling shape, and they have landed on the front page of the bulletin. They have come to win titles and be the best stable in the NPL.

**Juice:** The Andersons are the team to watch out for...

**Bob:** Juice this isn't a team Battle Royal. This is every man for himself. There can only be one winner. A HUGE opportunity on the line here. Jaxtyn Anderson won this last year. Good Luck to all.

**Jim:** So much on the line in that one. Speaking of a lot on the line...we have the Main Event. (*Fans Cheer!*)

*(Duke steps into the frame. Dressed in his new t-shirt, jeans, cowboy boots, Stetson on his head, and the National Patriots League World Heavyweight Championship over his right shoulder.)*

**Katie:** Duke, Monster’s Ball is here. You have a Main Event match with the Unstoppable Gaspar Mohammadi. He destroyed Huxley Anderson in his Ambulance Match. AND Jake Duval and the Asian Reclamation Squad could get involved in your Last Man Standing Match. The deck is clearly stacked against you...

**Duke:** I’m going to make this short and sweet. *(Looks into the camera.)* I have faced the toughest, the strongest, and the nastiest. But those men had something you don’t Gaspar. **Huxley:** We have been up and down every road here in the US while wrestling for this organization. The 4 of us have won many titles and have fought each other. No one is like Gaspar. Understand this... You go to Monster's Ball, and you win Duke. Not just for yourself, the fans, or for the Andersons. If you don't win... they will have all the gold. That can't happen here. As for the Reclamation Squad, if they get involved then we got your back. Win Duke, Win!

*(Fans chant Win Duke Win repeatedly! Duke tips his Stetson and walks down the hallway.)*

Malcolm Mack dressed in his merch shirt that says, "You want the smoke?". Malcolm sits to the right of the shot smoking his cigar. Then Justice Mack enters the room. He's wearing a navy-blue jumpsuit and is accompanied by an entourage. He then sits on the other end of the table. Commissioner Jaxx speaks.)*

**Commissioner Jaxx:** Good evening gentlemen. Thank you for being here. I've spoken to both your lawyers and representatives. And there is to be no physicality during this. Understood?

*(Both men nod.)*

**Justice Mack:** Yea Jaxx let's get this over with. And can you tell this buster to put that stank cigar out?

**Malcolm:** He never did want the smoke... *(Malcolm puts out his cigar.)*

I wanted to be just like my big brother. I may not of had your courage, but if I had you by my side then everything would be alright. I believed in my big brother. I believe you are a NPL World Heavyweight Champion waiting to happen! We been through A LOT together! But you broke this family. Now I have to do what I have to do. You broke my heart bruh...

*(Malcolm walks out of the room. Justice jumps out of his seat and tries to go after Malcolm, but Commissioner Jaxx and Rags2Riches security stops the angry Mack brother.)*

**-Commercial Break-**



*(Card 17: Held in Yonkers, NY. Declan Deadeye was in the ring awaiting his opponent for the night, “The Big Ticket” T-Money. In the Gorilla position he awaited his music. Suddenly all the lights from the monitors and everyone in the gorilla position weren’t there...One back light was on. A silhouette of a dark figure was standing there. T-Money in a rage ran over to it. He spears this man.)*

**T-Money:** I got you Muerte!

*(As the lights come back on, Commissioner Jaxx comes over and pulls T back. The electrician Harold had long hair, dressed in black and had a dress hat on. Jaxx speaks.)*

**Jaxx:** What are you doing? That’s Harold! He’s our electrician handling the problem we have been having tonight. Have you had any sleep T?

**T-Money:** *(Shoves Jaxx off him.)* Mind your business, Jackson!

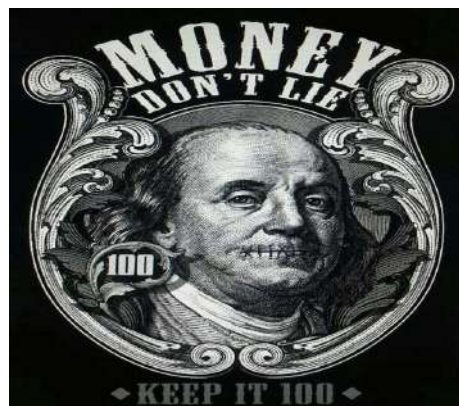
**Jaxx:** I’m calling your match. Go home.
