XD LIVE : A recap package rolls highlighting the chaotic conclusion of last cycle's Xtreme Dose, showcasing the confrontation, tension, and unanswered questions that left the XPL on edge. The video fades out and cuts LIVE inside the Xtreme Arena, where over 11,000 fans are on their feet buzzing with anticipation. Suddenly, the arena falls into darkness, and a low roar builds before erupting as the lights reveal the XPL World

Heavyweight Champion, Voice of the Voiceless, standing in the ring with the championship draped over his shoulder. Moments later, the mood shifts as The Mighty Deadhead appears at the top of the ramp—alone, without Mockingbird or Gourdman. The crowd reacts loudly as Deadhead makes a slow, deliberate walk to the ring, never taking his eyes off the champion. He steps inside and gets directly in Voice's face, the tension becoming suffocating as heated words are exchanged. Deadhead can be heard saying, "it's just me and you", and that is all it takes for the two men to erupt into a brawl, trading fists in the center of the ring. XPL Security quickly floods the ring to intervene, pulling them apart as they continue to struggle and shout, still trying to get at one another. As the chaos continues, attention shifts to the Poison-Tron where Commissioner Venom Scott appears on the screen, drawing a massive reaction from the crowd as the situation is about to be made official.



Commissioner Venom Scott appears on the Poison-Tron as the chaos continues in the ring, his presence immediately commanding attention. He wastes no time, ordering both Voice of the Voiceless and The Mighty Deadhead to leave the arena immediately, stating that it is necessary to protect the main event at Sole Survivor. He makes it crystal clear—if either man refuses, the match will not happen, and the XPL World Heavyweight Championship will be vacated. The crowd erupts in boos at the ultimatum as tensions continue to boil over between the two competitors. Reluctantly, both men are escorted out by security, still jawing at one another as they disappear from view. Scott then shifts focus, reminding everyone of tonight's main event: **Xavier Vaughn Xtreme versus Tyrant Hero for the XPL American Championship**. He emphasizes that there must be a winner, reinforcing the no-excuses, no-draw stipulation. He then raises the stakes even higher, announcing that the winner of that match will earn a spot in the upcoming

WarGames Match, joining **Redwolf**. Scott follows that by revealing the second entrant—the **Demonic Gourdman**—drawing a strong reaction from the crowd. With a firm and confident tone, Scott declares that the XPL is changing and that the level of competition will only get tougher as the year progresses. He thanks the fans in attendance for their energy and support, but before anything else can be said, the screen suddenly fills with static and cuts out, leaving the audience buzzing about what's to come.

The scene transitions backstage.

Backstage, the camera finds **Chris Marinaro, Eddie Raja, and Sam McMillan** standing together, the atmosphere serious and reflective. Marinaro speaks first, his tone calm but firm, addressing the growing fracture within the group. He reveals that **Dragonite has refused to answer his calls**, making it clear that he's made his decision to walk away from the faction. Marinaro pauses, letting that reality settle in, before saying that everyone needs to take note of what's happening and shift their focus inward. He explains that maybe, just maybe, if each of them locks in on their own path, that focus could eventually bring them back together someday.

Raja steps forward, intensity immediately taking over. He looks straight into the camera and throws out a direct challenge to **Hercules** for the **X-Contenderz Championship at Sole Survivor**. His voice sharpens as he raises the stakes, declaring that if he cannot get the job done, then he will **never challenge for that title again**. McMillan places a hand on Raja's shoulder, backing him without hesitation. He reminds everyone that Raja is the **greatest X-Contenderz Champion of all time**, and confidently states that it's only a matter of time before he holds that championship once again.

The three men stand united—for now—as the camera lingers on their determined expressions before the scene cuts to a promotional break.

He announces that **Commissioner Venom Scott** has made it official—at **Sole Survivor**, they will defend the titles against the **former champions, Da Hardcore Luchadore and Devon Demon**. Manukas makes it clear that this is exactly what they wanted. No substitutions. No excuses. He says they didn't come this far to beat a stand-in—they want the real thing. They want both former champions at full strength so there are no questions when it's all said and done.

Warner steps in beside him, a confident smirk on his face. He adds that whether it's one of them or both of them... the result is going to be exactly the same.

The crowd reacts loudly as the champions raise their belts one more time before turning and walking out of frame, leaving their message clear and their confidence unquestioned.

The main event is set as the Xtreme Arena comes alive with anticipation. **Tyrant Hero** makes his entrance first, focused and intense, eyes locked on the ring as he prepares for the opportunity in front of him. Backstage, "**Bloodline Itch**" **Eddie Raja** is shown pacing back and forth, clearly frustrated, the weight of the Tombstone Masterz drama still lingering on him. He stops, looks into the camera, and exhales before speaking.

Raja starts by congratulating **Hercules** on capturing the **X-Contenderz Championship**, giving him his respect. He reminds Hercules—and everyone watching—of the history they share since returning to the XPL late last year. He acknowledges the rise of the Olympians and what they've accomplished, but makes it clear that this isn't about factions or alliances.

This is personal.

Raja says that despite the respect he has for Hercules and his crew, there's one thing he needs—**one more shot** at the championship that he made famous: the X-Contenderz Title.

He pauses, then smirks slightly.

"You might say no," Raja admits. "But I know the kind of champion you are. A fighting champion. And something tells me... you might just take me up on it."

He steps closer to the camera, intensity rising.

"You think you're better than I was?"

A beat.

"Let's find out."

Raja stares into the lens, unwavering, as the challenge is laid out. The scene fades, leaving the question hanging—will Hercules accept?

Backstage, the camera snaps on to **The Dynamic Dragonite**, but something is different. Gone are the bright, flamboyant colors—replaced now with a cold, calculated **black and white attire**. His presence feels heavier. Focused. Dangerous.

He steps closer to the camera, eyes locked in.

“Dominance... Vision... Control.”

The words echo with intensity as he points to himself.

Dragonite says he’s done with the noise, the arguing, the constant tension that plagued **Tombstone Masterz**. He calls it a distraction—something that held him back from what he truly is. He makes it clear he’s not here to fix anyone else anymore.

“I’m not a peacemaker,” he says sharply. “I’m here to bring peace to myself... and if that means bringing destruction to anyone who steps in my way—so be it.”

He paces slightly, then stops.

He brings up **Redwolf**, saying he doesn’t know if the offer will be accepted—but it still stands. If Redwolf wants to continue dominating the XPL, there’s a place for him.

Dragonite then straightens up, pride in his voice.

“Let’s not forget something,” he says. “I’m in the history books. The **first XPL World Heavyweight Champion**—ever.”

His tone shifts to dismissive.

“And that so-called ‘champion’ before me? Jolly Jim?” He scoffs. “There was no crown until I took it.”

He leans in closer to the camera, intensity rising.

“The fire still burns. And when the time comes... anybody standing in my way...”

A slight pause.

“They’re getting burned.”

He steps back, eyes still locked forward.

“Sole Survivor: WarGames.”

Another pause.

“If you’ve got a problem with me...”

A cold smirk forms.

“See me there.”

The camera lingers on his new, darker presence as the segment fades—Dragonite no longer looking for acceptance, but ready for war.

“Fed-Ex” Chris Warner & “Wild Man” Lucas Manukas



Fed-Ex” Chris Warner and “Wild Man” Lucas Manukas stand side-by-side—each man draped in TWO championship belts.

Warner: “Look at this, Rick... no, scratch that—look at us. XPL World Tag Team Champions... and now, PWI Universal Tag Team Champions. Elijah Thorne. Eli Richter. You boys stepped up, and you pushed us to the limit—but in the end, the result was exactly what we promised.”

Manukas: “DOUBLE CHAMPS, BABY! HA! I told the whole world this was gonna be a Wild Ride, and what happened?! We ran right through the best of the LWL and took their gold home with us! Two teams down, two sets of titles up—and we’re just gettin’ started!”

Warner: “See, this isn’t luck. This isn’t coincidence. This is what happens when preparation meets opportunity. We don’t just show up—we deliver. And now the entire tag team world is on notice.”

Manukas: “ANY team. ANY promotion. You think you’re the best? You think you’ve got what it takes? Then step up and take your shot! But fair warning—you step into the ring with Wild Delivery...”

BOTH: “...YOU’RE IN FOR A WILD RIDE!”

Warner: “We’re not just champions... we’re the standard now.”

The two men raise their titles high as the camera zooms in on the gleaming gold. Fade out.



Xtreme Poison League — Group Promo: “Venom Unleashed”

(Camera pans across a smoky arena. Six shadows emerge — the hiss of serpents echoing through the speakers. The lights flicker green as the voices rise one by one.)

King Cobra: “The crown’s dripping venom tonight! The Serpent Society bows to no one — we rule this pit with fangs and fury!”

Big Boa: “You can run, you can hide, but when I coil around you, it’s lights out! The League squeezes the life outta every pretender!”

Black Mamba: “Fast strikes, silent kills — we don’t talk about dominance, we *demonstrate* it. One blink, and your legacy’s gone!”

Bushmaster: “From the jungle to the ring, I bring chaos! You step in with us, you’re not fighting wrestlers — you’re facing predators!”

Taipan: “Every move we make is precision poison. We infect this league with fear, and there’s no cure for what’s coming!”

Fer-De-Lance: “Tonight, the venom flows! We’re not here to win — we’re here to *eradicate*! The Xtreme Poison League doesn’t fight fair... we fight final!”

(All six raise their fists, snake-patterned gloves glinting under the lights.) **All Together:** “XTREME POISON LEAGUE — STRIKE FIRST. STRIKE DEADLY!”

*[The match has just ended. **Tyrant Hero** and **Dragon Hero** stand in the ring, having dispatched enhancement talent with cold efficiency. No celebration. Just business.]*

Tyrant's music fades.

He takes a microphone.

Dragon stands just behind him, catching his breath, unaware of what's coming.

Tyrant Hero:

"Death Killers."

(The crowd responds, a bit uncertain.)

"Get out here. Now."

[One by one, they arrive.]

Da Hardcore Luchadore, steel chair in hand.

Devon Demon, expression unreadable.

Da Leprechaun Gangsta, loose and watchful.

Silva G, rolling his shoulders like he walked into a bar he doesn't trust.

They line the ring.

Tyrant nods.

Tyrant Hero:

"I've heard... concerns."

(He paces slowly.)

"About leadership. About focus. About whether I'm too busy building something bigger... to protect what's right in front of me."

(A faint smirk.)

"I appreciate that."

The crowd murmurs.

Dragon looks slightly confused.

Tyrant Hero:

"It takes guts to speak up. Especially when you think something's slipping."

(He turns, locking eyes with Demon.)

"So let's not whisper about it. Let's not pass messages in hallways."

(beat)

"Let's handle it right here."

He gestures.

Tyrant Hero:

"Devon. Step forward."

[Demon does. Calm. Measured. No hesitation.]

The two stand face to face.

Tyrant places a hand on Demon's shoulder.

A gesture that almost feels... respectful.

Tyrant Hero (quietly):

“Thank you... for speaking up.”

—and then it happens.

A sudden, sharp motion. Tyrant Hero gives a swift Pat McAfee to the groin of the Child of Rage.

Demon folds instantly, dropping to one knee, then to the mat.

The arena gasps. Loud. Unified.

Dragon freezes.

DHL takes a step forward — instinct — then stops.

Tyrant doesn't hesitate.

What follows isn't chaos.

It's control.

Every movement is deliberate. Measured. Cold.

Not rage. Not panic. A message.

Demon tries to rise once — and is forced back down by a hefty boot from the leader of DK.

The crowd noise shifts from confusion... to discomfort.

Dragon takes a step forward.

Stops.

He doesn't understand what he's seeing.

Tyrant Hero (calm, almost teaching):

“You don't question the foundation... while standing on it.”

He reaches out — and demands the trademark steel chair from Da Hardcore Luchadore.

DHL doesn't hand it over, but he also doesn't fight to hold on to it.

But his posture changes.

Rigid.

Torn.

Tyrant turns back to Demon.

The chair becomes punctuation.

Not chaos.

Finality.

Another shot, then another. The sickening thud resonates through the hallways of the arena and the minds of the onlookers.

At ringside, the energy breaks.

Da Leprechaun Gangsta backs toward the ropes, shaking his head.

Silva G mutters something under his breath, jaw tight.

They slide out.

They don't intervene.

They don't approve.

They just... leave.

DHL lingers a moment longer.

Looking down at Demon.

Looking at Tyrant.

Something cracks behind the mask.

Then slowly...

He turns. And follows.

[They gather at the top of the ramp. Not united. Not proud. Just... there.]

In the ring, it's just Tyrant, Dragon... and what's left of the moment.

The crowd is loud now. Not cheering.

Reacting.

Tyrant sets the chair down.

Looks at Dragon.

Picks it up again.

And presses it into his brother's hands.

Tyrant Hero:

"Finish him."

The words hit harder than anything before.

Dragon doesn't move.

His hands grip the chair.

But his body... refuses.

He looks at Demon.

Then at Tyrant.

Then back again.

A long moment.

Too long.

Dragon Hero (quiet, shaken):

"...I can't."

The words barely leave his mouth.

But they're there.

They hang.

Tyrant's expression changes.

Not anger.

Not yet.

Something colder.

Before anything else can happen—

[Security floods the ring.]

Officials, referees, XPL personnel.

They separate them. Pull Tyrant back. Shield Demon.

The moment fractures into noise.

Tyrant doesn't fight them.

He doesn't need to.

He's already said everything.

Dragon stands frozen, chair still in his hands.

At the top of the ramp, the rest of DK watches.

Not as a unit.

As witnesses.

[Final shot: Devon Demon being helped, barely moving... Dragon Hero staring at the chair...

Tyrant Hero watching it all with unsettling calm.]



MIGHTY DEADHEAD:
 VOICE OF THE VOICELESS... I GOTTA ADMIT, IT'S REAL FUNNY. YOU OUT HERE COMPLAININ', WHININ', CRYING ABOUT HAVING TO DEFEND THAT TITLE AGAINST THE MUST SEE MAULER... THE MIGHTY DEADHEAD. TAKE YOUR WHINING AND STICK IT WHERE THE SUN DON'T SHINE. THIS IS STILL THE DEADHEAD ERA. AND I NEVER GOT MY REMATCH. SO NOW YOU DON'T GET EXCUSES. YOU GET ME.

ALL THE MILLIONS OF DEADHEAD FANS WANT TO SEE THE MIGHTY ONE TAKE THE TITLE BACK JACK. AND FAT DADDY DEADHEAD HATES TO DISAPPOINT HIS FANS.

CHRISTY MARINANA... YOU KEEP RUNNIN' YOUR MOUTH ABOUT KEEPIN' THE TITLE OUT OF MY HANDS... ABOUT WHAT THIS LEAGUE DESERVES. THIS LEAGUE DESERVES A REAL CHAMPION. IT DESERVES A STANDARD BEARER. AND BOY - NEXT TIME I'M IN THAT RING FACING YOU... I WILL SMASH YOU.

H-2-HO... WHEN I GO OUT THERE, THE WHOLE XPL SHOULD BE PROUD WHEN I BRING THE PWI NETWORK WORLD TITLE HOME TO THE XPL! "WINKS"

I GOT YOUR MESSAGE DOCTOR PAIN. AND I WILL DELIVER!

STRONG MACHINES MOM:
 THAT'S RIGHT, BECKY. HE'S THE MAN. AND MAYBE... JUST MAYBE... HE CAN TEACH HIM HOW TO BE MORE OF A MAN. HOW TO CARRY HIMSELF LIKE AN ALPHA... LIKE DEADHEAD DOES.

HE KNOWS ALL THE RIGHT MOVES... IN THAT RING... AND OUT OF IT. HE PUTS ME IN MORE HOLDS THAN ANYBODY. THE DEAD SLEEPER... THE TEXAS CLOVERLEAF... THE FULL NELSON... THE FIGURE FOUR... AND HE ALWAYS KNOWS HOW TO MAKE ME TAP OUT... IN THE BEST WAY.

"SHE SMILES, GRABS DEADHEAD'S FACE" YOU'RE MY CHAMPION... MY ALPHA... MY EVERYTHING.

"THEY KISS"

DEMONIC GOURDMAN:
 I CALL THIS... "RIP... RIP, REST IN PAIN." NAMES... BROKEN. BODIES... BURIED. CAREERS... ENDED.

ARMAS ARCHULETTA... BLACK ARMAS... EL PASCADITO... RICKY REYES... THE ITALIAN NIGHTMARE... CRIMSON CYCLONE... THE HARDCORE ROOKIE... KEVIN "THE BETRAYER"...

DYNAMIC DRAGONITE... I PROMISED THAT LAST MATCH WAS THE FINISH.

SO I'LL KEEP MY WORD. NOW... I WANT THE AMERICAN TITLE. OR THE TV TITLE. EITHER WAY... ANOTHER NAME GETS ADDED TO THE GRAVEYARD.

MIGHTY MOCKINGBIRD:
 HEY! HOLD ON! I STILL WANT A TITLE TOO! I'VE BEEN PATIENT, I'VE BEEN WAITING. BUT I'M DONE WAITING.

I'LL FIGHT ANYONE. OLYMPIANS? BRING 'EM. JERKULES. PUSSEIDON. GAYRES. I DON'T CARE WHO IT IS... I'LL DESTROY ANY OF THEM AND PUT THEM RIGHT BACK INTO THE FLOODHUB MATCH VAULT!

BECAUSE WHEN YOU'RE WITH DOCTOR PAIN... YOU ACTUALLY USE SKILL... NOT BINGO, SKILL!

"RIPS OFF SHIRT TO REVEAL IWA SUPERFRIENDS SHIRT WITH GRABBIT THE RABBIT" AND I GOT PLENTY OF IT!

[Scene: XPL Backstage – Becky Boobie stands with a mic. The Circle of Tyrants is assembled. Executioner, Max Violence, and Tickle Me Pitbull stand like statues behind the group, arms crossed. Mighty Deadhead sits front and center, relaxed, confident. Strong Machine’s Mom stands behind him, rubbing his shoulders, completely locked in on him like he’s the main event of the world.]

Mighty Deadhead Segment

Becky Boobie:
 “I’m here with Mighty Deadhead ahead of his huge opportunity at the XPL World Championship—”

Mighty Deadhead (interrupting, smirking):
 Opportunity?

(Becky pauses. Deadhead leans forward.)

Mighty Deadhead:
 Becky... I don’t get opportunities.
 I *am* the opportunity.

Strong Machine’s Mom squeezes his shoulders, smiling.

Strong Machine's Mom:

You sure are...

Deadhead nods slightly.

Mighty Deadhead:

Voice of the Voiceless... I gotta admit, I think it's real funny.

You out here complainin'... whining... crying...
about having to defend that title...

Against the *Must See Mauler*...
The *Mighty Deadhead*.

(He shakes his head.)

Man, take that whining... and stick it where the sun don't shine.

Because this?

(He gestures around.)

This is still the Deadhead Era.

And I never got my rematch.

So now?
Now you don't get excuses.

You get *me*.

Strong Machine's Mom leans down closer.

Strong Machine's Mom:

They all want to see you win it back...

Mighty Deadhead:

Yeah... millions of Deadhead fans out there...

They don't wanna hear excuses.

They wanna see *The Mighty One* take that title back, jack.

And fat daddy.

(He smirks. And points towards the sky.)

I hate disappointing my fans.

Mighty Deadhead (turns to camera):

And Christy Marinara...

You keep runnin' your mouth about "protecting the title"...
about what this league "deserves."

Let me tell you something.

This league deserves a *real* champion.

It deserves a standard bearer.

It deserves someone who makes this place *move*.

And next time I'm in that ring with you?

(He steps forward slightly, voice dropping.)

I'm not just beating you.

...I'm smashing you.

Strong Machine's Mom (interrupting, dreamy):

And maybe after that... you can teach him—

(She gestures vaguely toward the locker room.)

—how to be more of a man.

How to carry himself like an Alpha... like you do.

Deadhead chuckles.

Mighty Deadhead:

That's a masterclass, sweetheart.

(She wraps her arms around his shoulders and he smirks, playing into it without going further.)

Mighty Deadhead (back to business):

And let's not forget H-2-Ho.

Because when I go out there?

When I step into that match?

The whole XPL better be proud...

Because I'm bringing the *PWI Network World Title* home.

(He winks at the camera.)

I got your message, Doctor Pain...

...and I'll deliver.

Demonic Gourdman Segment

[Camera shifts slightly. Demonic Gourdman steps forward holding a worn, torn list.]

Demonic Gourdman:

I call this...

“RIP... Rest in Pain.”

(He slowly reads.)

Names... broken.

Bodies... buried.

Careers... ended.

(He drags a finger down the list... pauses.)

Dynamic... Dragonite.

(A slow grin forms.)

I promised...

That last match was the finish.

So I'll keep my word.

(He folds the list.)

Now?

I want something new.

Something shiny.

Something worth taking.

The American Title...

Or the TV Title.

Either way?

Another name...

Gets added.

Mockingbird Interruption

Mighty Mockingbird (from the side, yelling):

HEY—hold on!

(Everyone looks. He steps forward, fired up.)

I still don't have a title!

I've been patient. I've been waiting.

But I'm done waiting.

I'll fight *anyone*.

Olympians?

Bring 'em.

Jerkules.

Pusseidon.

Gayres.

I don't care who it is—

I'll knock 'em all down and send 'em right back to the Floodhub vault!

Because when you're with Doctor Pain?

You use *skill*.

Not luck. Not bingo. Not shortcuts.

SKILL.

(Mockingbird rips off his shirt dramatically—revealing an **IWA Superfriends shirt with Grabbit the Rabbit.**)

Mighty Mockingbird:

And I got plenty of it!

Final Shot

[Executioner steps slightly forward... silent... intense. Max Violence cracks his neck. Tickle Me Pitbull smirks.]

Deadhead stands tall at the front again.

Mighty Deadhead (final line):

XPL... you're looking at the future...

And the present.

And the past.

Because no matter what changes?

This place still runs...

...through me.

[Fade out.]
