Rick Challenger: It isn't uncommon for stars to butt heads with the Front Office, but the bitter feud between the mask hating WTL Commissioner, Cactus Jacque and the hated veteran, Senor Lucha boiled over and led to this bout. Wary of Senor Lucha's Big Tess Stickles, who acts more like a tag team partner than a valet, Jacque roped in IWA Boss Johnny B. himself to keep her in check. This one featured all the wild brawling you'd expect from two over-the-hill dudes who get gassed at the ring bell, but the fans ate it up as they laid into each other. Lucha tweaked his knee when he landed a double axe handle to the floor and Cactus battered Lucha's leg mercilessly the rest of the match. It looked like it was over as Senor used the ropes to hold himself up and Jacque readied a steel chair to take out the knee, but then Lucha rebounded off the rope and hit his Million Peso Knee Strike to drive the chair into Jacque's face! Lucha staggered around the ring as the ref counted Jacque out by reaching 10 and gave Lucha a win but at a mighty cost as he was helped to the back by his Big Tess Stickles. [498-495]

Shooter Simmons: Two of the most unique stars in the IWAR, so of course they came up with a novel way to settle this feud. I was expecting the master of disguise Chameleon to pull some hijinks, but he was dead serious at the start. Kane came out fired up as well, but he took control at the point where he complained to the ref about hair pulling, but then mule kicked Chameleon! This gave him the chance to hit his Punchline and take the first fall. [499-492, Fall 1] The Chameleon was mad about falling for that one and recovered quickly and took Kane off guard with his combo of strikes. As he poured it on, the momentum shifted, but the ever-crafty veteran, Logan used the famous Japanese move, the eye rake, to disorient the Chameleon for a roll up, but the man of 1000 faces pushed off the bottom rope to shift his weight and get a sneaky quick three count to even the match up. [489-488, Fall 2, 1-1] This became pretty much became a Submission match, since the only way to gain, total victory, was make your opponent submit and for the next twenty minutes these two shifted from a battering offense to a grinding attack that wore down the limbs. Chameleon went after Kane's knee and Logan targeted the shoulder with an assortment of violent strikes followed by wear down holds. 
Rick Challenger: There's a number of reasons Phil is champ. Like his Millennial Reign pals, Arte Fischel and Benny Factor.
