Every cycle each individual wrestler's points in a stable are added together then divided by the number with those stable initials, no matter if they are active or not. If they are in the rankings they count. This is only for bragging rights. There are no prizes for stable of the year.

The Regulators defended the IWL against Revolution Extreme, brought down the Foreign Legion and have never lost a war. Even ending careers along the way.



WM: “I uh...I didn’t know that was something you were supposed to do...”



The entire group now stands united on the entrance ramp, each member a vital part of the whole. Jackknife Justice raises his mic one last time....

Jackknife Justice: Mark our words, everyone in that locker room, everyone watching at home.... DYNASTY is here to reign supreme. Get ready, because we're taking over, and there's nothing you can do about it!

The crowd responds with a thunderous mix of reactions as DYNASTY's music blares once more. The scene fades out, leaving an indelible impression of the new era in pro wrestling, led by the powerhouse DYNASTY.

A huge white zero comes on the big screen at ringside and fans cheer. The lights go out and the only light in the arena is a white zero in the middle of the ring. The camera focuses on that until fans cheer even louder. A camera scans into the crowd in the upper deck where a masked wrestler stands with them. He begins to make his way down to the ring with fans cheering all around him. The masked wrestler continues to walk down the steps. His theme music plays loudly, and fans can be seen bobbing their heads to it as he passes them. The light just shines on his location and the big bright white zero in the ring is all that can be seen. The masked wrestler stops a few times and poses with younger fans who have wrestler masks on. When he gets to the ring barricade, he jumps over it and makes his way up the steel steps and before entering the ring he wipes his feet and looks one more time to the sold-out crowd. He grabs a mic from the attendant and stands in the ring under the only light in the arena. The white zero still very bright in the ring and the masked wrestler shields his eyes for a moment then puts the mic to his mouth. Fans quiet down and listen to see what he will say.

Ø: A... C... W... Cero Miedo!

The fans explode into a loud cheer as Ø drops the mic and holds up his hands and motions with the crowd. The camera follows him out of the ring and back over the barricade where he walks up the steps and through the crowd on the other side of the arena. He makes sure to stop and take selfies and sign autographs for all the young fans he passes. ACW fans then get to meet the masked wrestler in the merchandise section of the arena where he sells replica masks. Social media went crazy after the show saying Ø was the main attraction and many fans shared their pictures and videos with him during the event. ACW just signed a real superstar.

I personally took care of him in CWL and made sure there is no way he will be in the ACW this month. After what I put him through in England, there is no way he will be able to make it. I assure you sir; he is never coming to ACW! Yes, I know how much money you are paying me. Yes, I know I guaranteed he would not survive the first time. I know... Sir, I am arriving at the arena right now. I will be here personally just in case he does make it. I will make sure to make him disappear for good this time.

Amen Spur gets out of the limo and walks through the parking garage and through the backstage area of the arena. Everyone moves out of his way as he makes his way to the Commissioner's office. He opens the door without knocking and walks in, making sure to close the door before the camera can come inside with him. After a few minutes the door opens, and Amen Spur walks out and begins to make his way towards the ring. He walks out onto the ramp and fans boo loudly as he walks down to the ring announcers table and sits down and waits.

*A camera crew backstage run towards the parking garage where a huge bus pulls in with Luthor Alexander's face all over it. A split view hits the screen with the bus and the facial reaction of Amen Spur who is sitting at the announcer's table. The doors to the bus open and fans cheer loudly with anticipation of Luthor Alexander's first moment in the new league. ACW officials and security personnel can be seen standing outside of the bus waiting for the arrival of the greatest superstar to ever sign with a rookie league. A photographer stands with the growing crowd of people outside of the bus. He gets ready for the picture that will make him famous in every wrestling magazine around the world. Amen Spur's angrily sits in his chair watching the screen with the cheering fans. The announcer's try to build up the anticipation for the fans back at home but every time they mention Luthor's name Amen Spur glares at them and they just sit in fear watching the big screen. Finally, movement can be seen on the bus. Fans cheer even louder as a shot of his wrestling boots can be seen and fans get even louder as the camera pans up the legs, the torso, the body, and then a loud groan of disappointment can be heard through out the crowd as it is someone else, someone dressed in Luthor Alexander gear. Amen Spur can be heard laughing as he stands up and makes his way into the ring. The Luthor Alexander imposter makes his way to the ring through the backstage area. Fans begin to boo very loudly as Amen Spur laughs over the crowd. The imposter Luthor Alexander comes down the ramp and gets in the ring. Amen Spur shakes his hand and laughs one more time before welcoming the greatest star in the IWA to the ACW. (The imposter is actually **Bixby Bludworth**)*

Amen Spur: Welcome to ACW, Luthor Alexander.

Fans boo even louder as the two men just stand there laughing. Just then Luthor Alexander's music hits and fans explode into another huge cheer. [Tune in next time]

RIO

The masked wrestler Russian Invader 0 stands in the middle of the ring covering his ears as fans boo loudly. He does not ask for a microphone; he does not need one. Fans in the crowd or at home watching on their devices would not be able to hear him even if he did possess one, which he does not and in no way does he ever want or need a microphone to show his Russian pride. He knows that the great people of his country stand united and very proud of RIO. He continues to hold his ears as the crazy Americans scream and boo as loudly as they can. If only they knew they were doing exactly what the men behind the curtain wanted them to do. They were eating right out of the boss's hand and paying good money to do it.

If only these petty Americans could see themselves right now. Standing there, booing like crazy people all dressed up in their Luthor Alexander t-shirts,

waving their silly signs around like they know how to read or write. Every single one of them stinks of beer and bad choices. RIO paid for this tv time and RIO was going to use every second of it to just stand there with his ears covered. This is the promo that will define what ACW stands for. This promo will go down in the history books as the most surreal promo ever done in an IWA ring. Johnny B will talk about this promo 20 years from now as one of the most important promos he has ever seen produced in the IWA. This promo would have made the original Johnny B. weep like a baby. RIO proudly stands in the center of the ring with ears covered and shielded by the boos. No professional wrestler has ever been booed this long or meanly in the history of the sport. RIO has just broke records with this promo and a smirk can be seen as he turns to make sure that the other side of the arena gets a chance to boo louder than the other side. The camera zooms in on the face of RIO and then pans through the booing crowd, making sure to stop and hype up the crowd even more to boo even louder once they saw their stupid faces on the big screen above the ring.




The announcer announced Russian Invader 0 as the first entrant into the ACW's first battle royal. Fans booed.






Enik the Altrusian
