

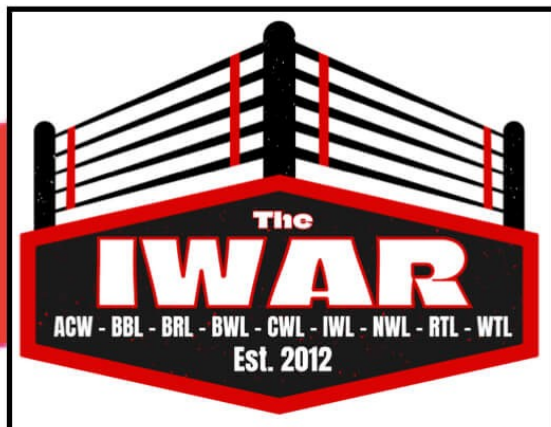

"And to whoever's behind all this..."

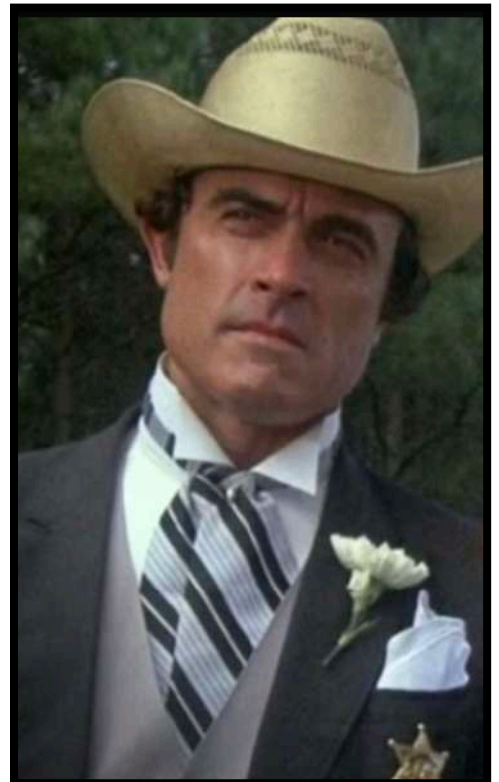
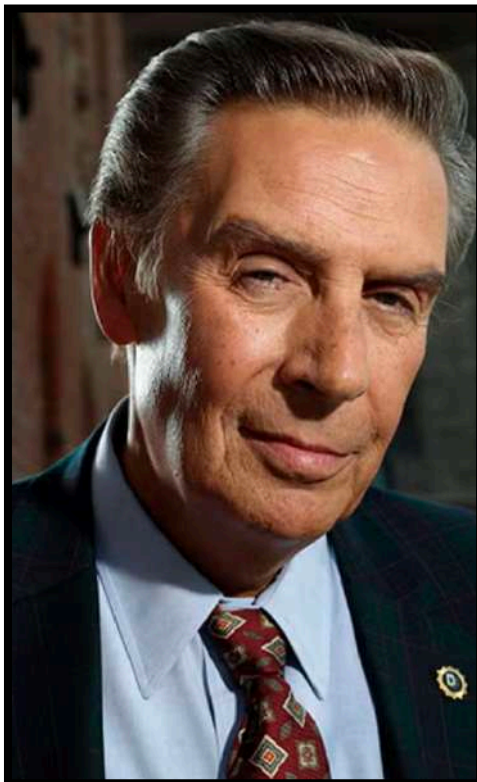
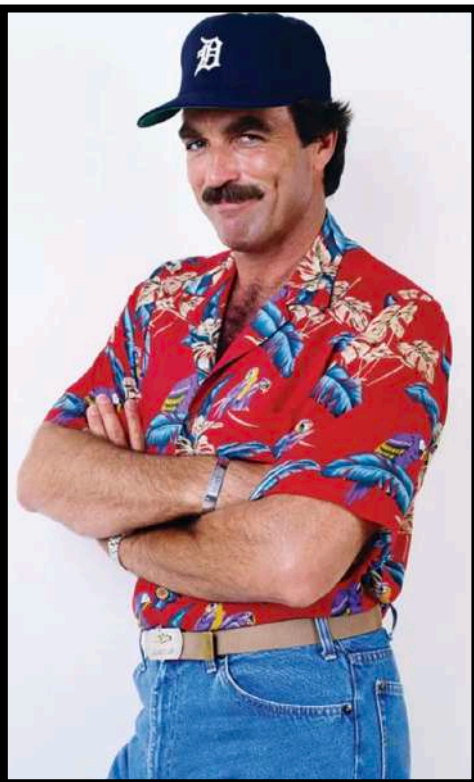

### COMMISSIONER'S CREDIT

### TRIPLE CROWN PRIZE POOL

If the same wrestler wins the League, League Tag, League Six-Man **AND sends in trash talk**, all in the same cycle, that wrestler wins the prize pool. For every cycle the prize is not won more matches and imaginary cash are added to the progressive pot.

### CHAMPIONS BATTLE ROYAL

ACW League, American Territories and regional champions from previous cycles will enter battle royals to determine the number one contenders for the Commissioner's singles titles. The same will be done to determine the number one contenders for tag and six-man titles. If more teams are needed wild cards could be entered. Winners are determined by highest point total. Tag-teams and six-man teams must send in a match the cycle the point totals are used so I have a total for the battle royal. Point flow is used as a tie breaker. **You must trash talk to be eligible.** If a wrestler is eligible to be on two or more tag-teams and/or six-man teams, the team that qualified first will be used.



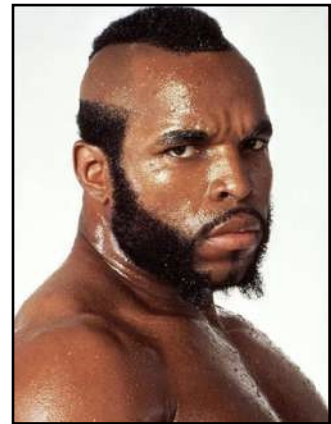

Leaving behind one question hanging over Willowick, Ohio:

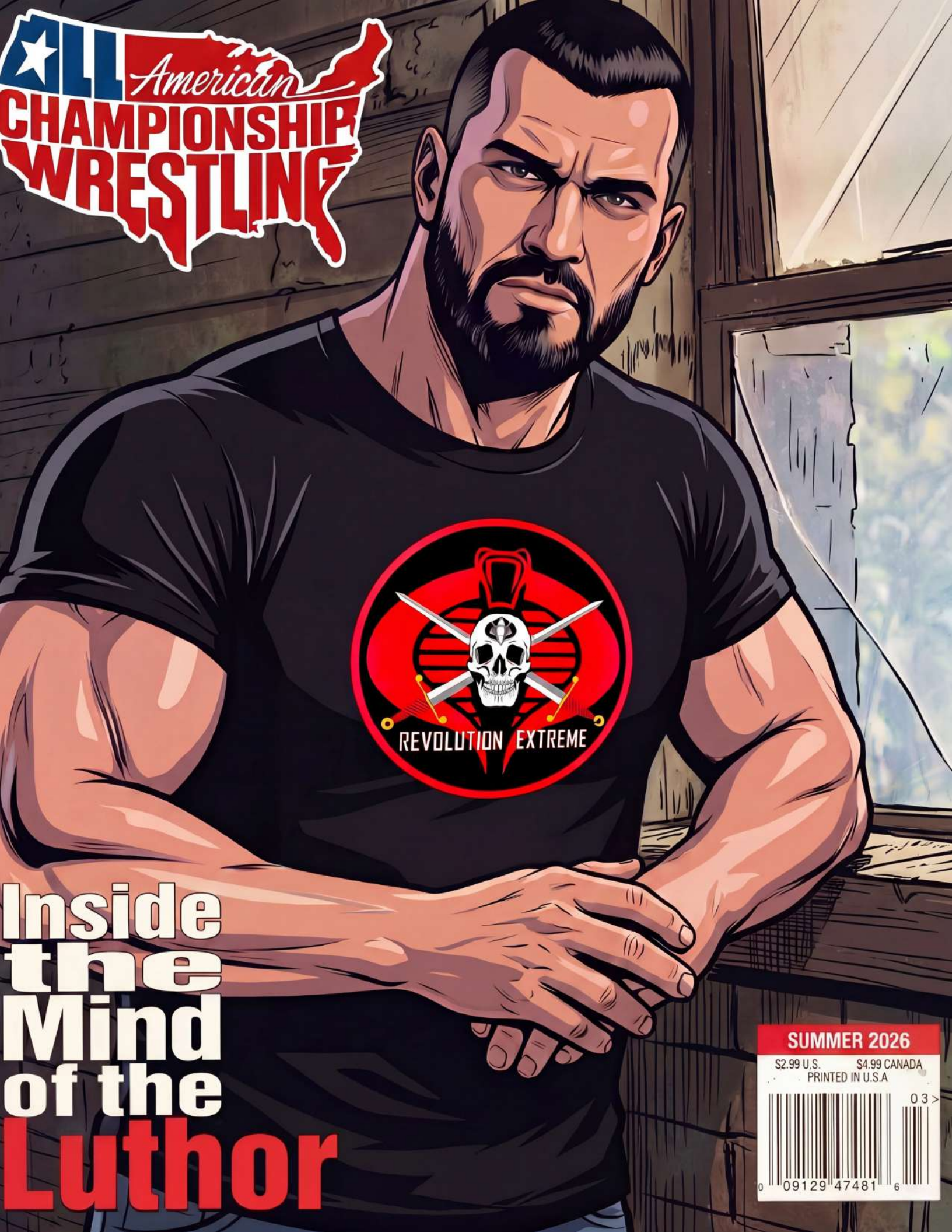

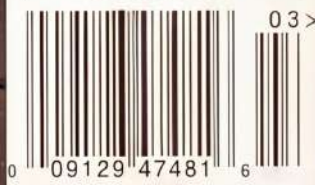

*He-Man Hoven: Sure, but I got you a limo. Driver, take her to the BWL Arena. (tips the driver) Well, going or not?*

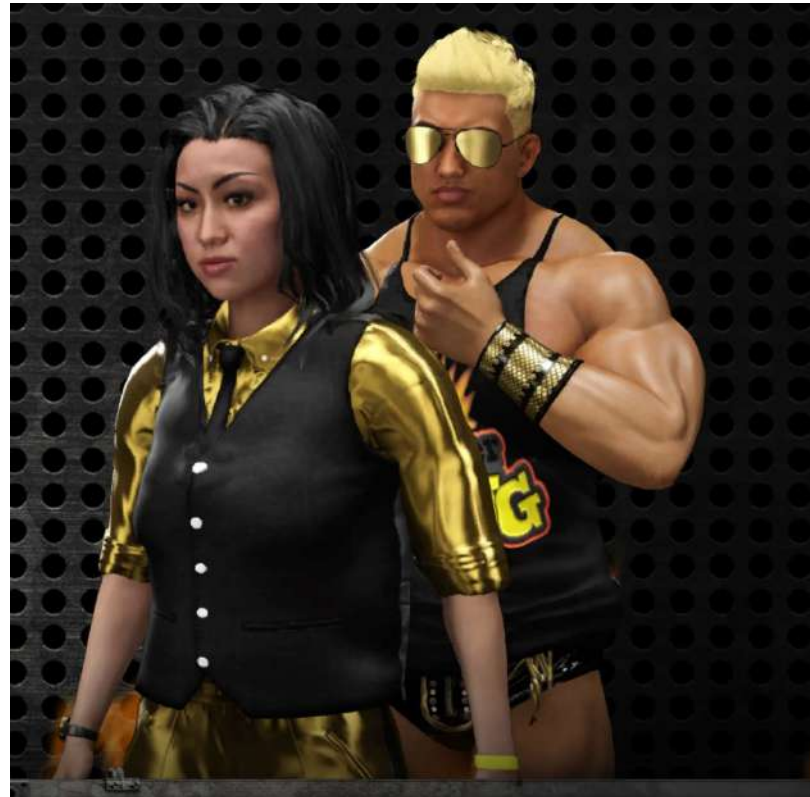
*Rachel Yamazaki: Uh, yeah, but I thought you-*
