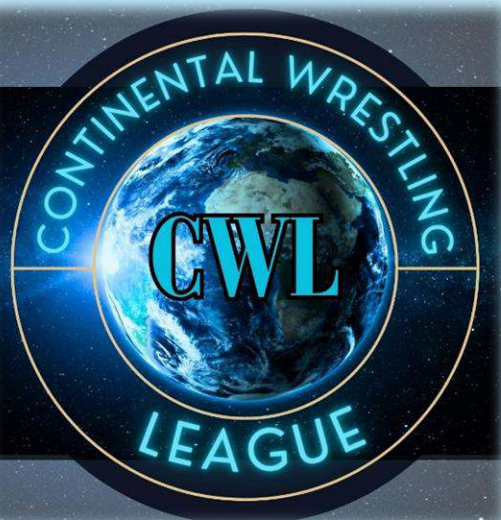

- RN: You can't get one over on Professor Algernon. I bet the old switcheroo was his idea!
- GT: All three teams are in the ring for this free-for-all. I thought the Von Snapps would be content to let the other two fight it out, but then Victor told his boys not to just stand there, but to beat someone.
- GS: Well, this one will be hard to follow as all three teams are going to be allowed to be in the ring at the same time, battling it out. This looks more like a battle royal. To top it all off, Commissioner Sam Solie announced earlier this evening that this match would be a no disqualification street fight.
- RN: Alex Von Snapp just threw the Nature Boy into the turnbuckle, but he flipped up and over the buckle and onto the apron. Alec Von Snapp met him with a clothesline, knocking him to the arena floor.
- GT: Nutty Bunny #1 has Axel Von Snapp in the corner, battering him with brutal chops.
- RN: I think that's Nutty Bunny #2, you idiot.
- GT: Sorry, they all look alike to me.
- GS: Don't look now but Phil Landers is sliding back into the ring with a steel chair. He nails two of the Nutty Bunnies with it, sending them outside. - GT: It looks like Alex Von Snapp has Arty Fischel up for a suplex. Is he going to suplex him from the ladder to the floor?
- RN: If he does, he needs Resmart, because he's going to hurt himself just as much as he'll hurt Fischel.

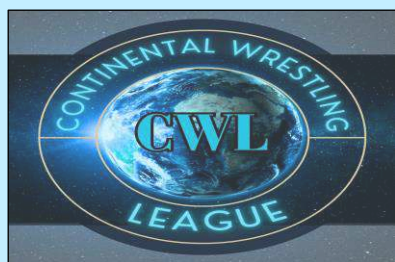

Back facing the camera, his right hand holding a cell phone to one ear.

JM: Jimmy?... Jimmy! It's Johnny.... No, Jimmy, no no no no, don't hang up, we needs you! ... You heard we got new representation? Yeah, that Smilac guy's gotta go! You should see these dressin' rooms... Hey, callin' him a grifter is an insult to all the honest to goodness grifters out there! Yeah, yeah, that's besides the point! Thing is, we're back! ... Whaddya mean "where"? In CWL.... Hey, hey, it ain't a bush league no more. They's got some solid teams here like the Von Snapps (*Johnny has to pull the phone away from his ear as a string of expletive laden shouting emits from the phone's speaker.*) An' a coupla new teams like... what's that one team's name, "Millenium Drain"? "Aluminium Brain"? Anyways these new kids wrestle a totally different style.... Um, well no, we ain't won any tag team gold yet, but once we knock the rust off we'll have those CWL Tag Team belts 'round our waists, just like ol' times.... Wha? The boss? Super focused on the title... whaddya mean "what title?", the ONLY title, the CWL World Title..... No, it ain't called that no more. Ever since the CWL was brought back into the IWAR they got world title status.... Whatcha mean you gotta go? Plane ticket? You comin'!? Jimmy? Jimmy?

Morello opens the door near him, rushing in.

JM: Hey, Vinni! Guess what? Jimmy's comin' back!

The camera opens with a wide panning shot of a raucous crowd, packed into an arena. A voice over of Gordon Tenay cuts in over the CWL Network television theme.

Gordon Tenay: Welcome back wrestling fans to the fastest growing show across the IWAR! *(View switches to a hard camera facing the announce team of Gordon Tenay at its center, flanked at either side by color commentator, Gibbon Storm, and expert analyst, Robert Neehan.)* Before we get to our next match ladies and gentlemen, we want to take you back to some footage of the recent traditional "end of tour" battle royal.

Robert Neehan: Battle royals are a crazy place to be. It's absolute chaos in the ring, and anything can happen.

GT: Indeed it can. With that said, let's go to the video.

The two roll upon the floor, a tangle of limbs and flailing fists. The referees at ringside attempt to break the two apart, to no avail. A veritable army of referees and blazer sporting officials, and security empty out of the back, eventually pulling the two wrestlers from each other's grasp. As CWL officials separate the two further, Alec breaks free from their grasp, vaulting himself at the crowd of people holding back Mike Mason. Seconds later Axel and Alex Von Snapp join the fray, evening the odds for their brother. The camera cuts back to the announce desk.)

GT: There you have it folks. The altercation between the Von Snapp brothers and Mason Enterprises ended up going on throughout the arena before CWL officials could restore order thanks, in no small part, to head of security Cordell Walker.

RN: I've never seen Alec Von Snapp literally "snap" like that. I've done some research on this Mike Mason... the guy's insane. He's power hungry, he's vicious, and he could be big trouble for the CWL if he gets his way.

Gibbon Storm: You can't deny the man has talent though. He's been racking up wins, and in this business, winning is what matters.

GT: He's been racking up wins, yes, but the manner in which he... What's this?

The searing guitar riff to Avenged Sevenfold's "Hail to the King" suddenly rips through the arena. A murmur of confused excitement ripples out from the audience in attendance, at the unfamiliar entrance music that possibly heralds a new, unknown wrestler. The house lights dim, taking on a red hue as the drums punctuate the fiery guitar tone blasting over the PA. As the song's main riff takes shape a spotlight breaks through the darkness to illuminate a lone figure standing at the entrance way. The spark of confusion and excitement quickly ignites into an explosion of anger-filled jeers as Mike "Freaking" Mason poses, with eyes closed, basking in the negativity his mere presence generates.

Harry rounds out his NWL tenure by winning its X-1 championship, some sort of hardcore title contrived by the league commissioner. Harry has never been able to wrap his mind around hardcore wrestling. He believes that if he's purchasing a ticket, whether to a baseball game, a Broadway play, or a wrestling show, the least he should expect for his money is to witness a professional doing his best to exhibit talent that the average person lacks.
