- GT: Our cameras have lost the wireless connection. I guess
 Mike Mason was right. He's not going to wrestle in a payper-view match unless it's the main event.
- GS: This is ridiculous! Lazarus Lane needs to fine Mason!
- RN: For what? He's a man of his word. He said he wouldn't settle for less than the main event and he meant it!

Winner: No Contest (494-494)

"Zodiac" Horace Cope vs. Reese Rutledge

- GS: This storm has been brewing for quite a while.
- RN: What storm? Is it raining?
- GT: Here comes Reese Rutledge. He wasn't going to compete in this match, but Lazarus Lane agreed to waive interest on the money Rutledge owes Lane if he wrestles tonight.

- GS: Collar and elbow tie up. Rutledge gets Cope in an arm wrench. Now a headlock.
- RN: He's looking to thrill the fans now!
- GT: Cope with a backdrop. (10 MINUTES LATER)
- GS: Rutledge has gained the upper hand. He has Cope in the corner and is standing on the second rope hitting Horace Cope with rights and lefts.
- RN: Cope never saw them coming. I thought he's psychic!
- GT: Now Rutledge whips Cope into the ropes. Oh, Cope just took out the referee when he bounced off the ropes. The ref just fell out of the ring and hit his head on the concrete floor. He may be out cold.
- GS: Rutledge hits a piledriver and covers Cope. But there's no referee. Reese gets off Cope and slides out of the ring. He's trying to revive the referee.
- GT: What is Cope doing? He just pulled a crystal ball out.
- RN: He's a magician and a seer. But why is he doing a reading in the middle of the match?
- GT: He's not. He just hit exploded that crystal ball all over the head of Reese Rutledge.
- GS: Rutledge is busted open and there's glass everywhere.
- GT: Now the ref gets in. 1...2...3. Cope pulled this one off.
- RN: Now he gets a stipulation. What will it be?
- GT: We'll find out next cycle!

Winner: "Zodiac" Horace Cope (492) over Reese Rutledge (489)

The American Patriot vs. Borg Genesis

- GT: The superhero versus the cyborg. It's a match the fans have been wanting to see since Superman and Terminator were in theaters.
- GS: There's the bell and we're underway. Patriot bounces off the ropes and can't move Borg at all with a shoulderblock. Now he bounces off again. Again, Borg doesn't move.
- RN: It's the unstoppable force versus the immovable object.
- GS: That's my line! (10 MINUTES LATER)



- GS: Patriot has been able to mount some offense, but it's been largely ineffective against Genesis.
- RN: Genesis hasn't even been knocked off his feet in this match.
- GT: Patriot now has Genesis dazed. Patriot hits Genesis with a superkick. Genesis is dazed. He falls to one knee.
- GS: Patriot is going to the top turnbuckle now. He's going to do a cross body from the top.
- RN: Genesis caught him and slammed him to the mat. I thought he was going through the ring. That's how hard Genesis slammed him into the mat.
- GT: Now Genesis picks Patriot up. A huge backbreaker. Now he's bending him backward over his knee. Now Genesis picks Patriot up again. A second backbreaker. He's again putting pressure on Patriot's head and lungs and driving that back into his knee.
- GS: Now Genesis picks Patriot up off the mat. He puts Patriot's head between his legs and flips him up. He's going to powerbomb him!
- GT: He's headed to the corner. He gave Patriot a powerbomb right into the ring post and the top turnbuckle. Patriot is hurt! The ref is stepping in and pushing Genesis away.
- RN: I think Patriot's really hurt.
- GT: The referee has stopped this match. Medical professionals are entering the ring. Here comes the stretcher. Patriot is being wheeled out to the ambulance. We'll give you an update on his condition later in the show.

Winner: Borg Genesis (492) defeated The American Patriot (490)

#1 Contender Match

Triple Six Rebels vs. Blitzkrieg and Kamikaze

- GT: Two new, up and coming teams square off for the chance to win the CWL tag titles at the next pay-perview.
- GS: This match promises to be a match people will remember for years to come. (25 minutes later)
- GT: These two teams have left their all in the ring tonight.

 We've seen power moves by the Triple Six Rebels and a fast, aerial-based attack from Blitzkrieg and Kamikaze.

- GS: Now, Blitzkrieg and Kamikaze have isolated Titanous to their side of the ring. He's been taking punishment for about ten minutes.
- GT: He did manage to crawl over and make the tag at one point, but the referee was distracted by Kamikaze and didn't see it.
- RN: If the ref didn't see it, it didn't happen.
- GT: Now Blitzkrieg tags in Kamikaze. Blitzkrieg puts
 Titanous on his shoulders while Kamikaze goes to
 the top rope. It looks like we're going to see a
 version of the Doomsday Device. No, Kamikaze
 comes off the top with a cross-body block but
 Titanous catches him in mid-air. He's holding
 Kamikaze while still on Blitzkrieg's shoulders.
- RN: This is unbelievable. I've never seen anything like it!
- GS: Now Castle comes in, bounces off the ropes, and takes Blitzkrieg out at the knees. His knees buckle, Titanous lands on him, while at the same time bringing Kamikaze to the mat with a powerbomb.
- GT: Now all four men are in. The referee is trying to restore order. He's trying to get Blitzkrieg out, but Castle and Titanous have put the Squeeze on Kamikaze.
- GS: Titanous just collapsed from exhaustion. Kamikaze is out, too. Castle puts Titanous on top of Kamikaze.
- GT: 1...2....3. The Triple Six Rebels will face the winner of the tag team title match later tonight at the next pay-per-view.

Red Scorpion 2 vs. Red Scorpion's Friend Doug

- GS: The bell rings, and we're underway! Robbie, any early thoughts?
- RN: Yeah, I've seen better matches at a kindergarten recess. Wake me when it's over.
- GT: Beautiful arm drag by Doug! He's surprising us already!
- RN: Even a blind squirrel finds a nut occasionally, Gibbon.
- GS: Amazing agility from Red Scorpion! These two are putting on a clinic!
- RN: Did you check your glasses today, Gibbon? Even a broken clock is right twice a day.
- GS: Moonsault! Doug might have it! One, two—NO! Scorpion kicks out!
- RN: Doug was closer to victory there than he's ever been to getting a date.
- GS: Spinning heel kick! What impact!
- RN: Doug might think twice about getting up after that!
- GS: Wait a minute! It's Doug's brother Craig, out here supporting!
- RN: Someone please turn Craig around, he's cheering for the popcorn vendor!
- GS: Craig just prevented Roman Rienv's interference!
- RN: Talk about blind luck! Craig's the best accidental enforcer I've ever seen!
- GS: The Stinger connects! Here's the count—one, two, three! Red Scorpion II takes it in an instant classic!
- RN: I can't believe I'm saying this, but that was a fantastic match, Gibbon.
- GS: What's this? Scorpion looks terrified!
- RN: Maybe he remembered he left the oven on.
- GS: Unbelievable! It's Akeem Bixenspan all along!
- RN: That's the biggest reveal since you showed your toupee, Gibbon.
- GS: What a moment! Respect between these two athletes.
- GS: Holy cow! Ricky Spanish out of nowhere with a vicious chair shot! The force of the blow bends the steel chair in half, leaving Akeem Bixenspan busted open and unconscious on the mat!
- RN: Oh No! He has a microphone.

Ricky Spanish: I'm tired of this f*****g clown show. I've been sitting in a cell for months, watching what the IWAR has become. Where are the warriors? Where are the fighters? All I see are stupid jokes, bad puns, swamp monsters, aliens, blind guys, cruiserweights—it's all types of bullshit. Lazarus Lane, it's true that Luthor Alexander sent me here to kill you. - GT: Genesis grabs Doug and lifts him straight up and throws him over the top rope into the ring from the floor.
- GS: What a feat of strength!
- GT: Here comes a referee. There's the bell.
- GS: Genesis picks up Doug and smashes his head into the turnbuckle.



GT: Doug may be out.

GS: Genesis picks him up again. A piledriver. There's the cover.

GT: Genesis wins in a time of 34 seconds.

RN: That's going to be hard to beat. I'm not a betting man, but I'd put all my money on Borg Genesis to be the #1 Contender to the Internet title.

WINNER: Dynasty: Borg Genesis (492) defeated Red Scorpion's Friend Doug (491) in 34 seconds

Beat the Clock Match #2 Alec Von Snapp vs. Thrash

- GT: To become the number one contender to the Internet title is next to impossible. One of these two wrestlers will have to win in 33 seconds or less.
- GS: Thrash comes out first, followed by Alec Von Snapp. Why isn't Alec getting in the ring?
- RN: Looks like he lost a contact lens or something.
- GT: This one will start as soon as Von Snapp gets in the ring.
- RN: Hey, look, it's a waitress from the Twin Peaks next door.
- GT: Yes, it is! She's climbing over the barrier and climbing onto the ring apron.
- GS: She's certainly caught the attention of Thrash.
- RN: She's not wearing a lot, but it's only a knot separating Thrash and heaven. Now, she's loosening that knot.
- GT: Thrash is in heaven. But wait, he just reached his hand out and she slapped him across the face.
- RN: Hey, look. Alec must have found his contact. He slides into the ring, the referee rings the bell.
- GS: Now Alec Von Snapp rolls up Thrash from behind. 1...2...3.
- GT: I can't believe it! He did it!
- GS: In just ten seconds, Alec Von Snapp beat Thrash. Now he's headed to the next pay-per-view to challenge for the Internet title.
- RN: Just when you think you've seen it all!

WINNER: Alec Von Snapp (496) defeated Thrash (490)

War Games Match to Determine #1 Contender to CWL World Title

- GT: Because of his injuries earlier tonight, American Patriot will not be able to compete in this match. That leaves four competitors: Norman "the Loon" Kevcus, Midnight Scorpion, Titus Castle, and Barry "USA" Stevens. One of these four will walk out tonight with a shot at the CWL World title.
- GS: All four competitors are in the ring. There's just one cage for this match, but it is enclosed. Once the cage is down, the match will start. Remember, no pinfalls will be counted. It's submit or surrender.
- GT: There's the bell and we're underway. (15 minutes later)
- GS: Who knew the CWL stored so many weapons under the ring? Midnight Scorpion has been pummeling everyone with a barbed wire baseball bat. Titus Castle is busted open. Norman the Loon is also busted open, but Barry Stevens had some brass knuckles in his trunks that busted him open.
- RN: Kevcus may be out. You can't submit if you're knocked out.
- GS: It makes it difficult. Scorpion and Stevens are now double teaming Titus Castle. Scorpion has Castle in a scorpion deathlock. Stevens has his Emotional Support Chair and he just nailed Castle with the chair. Castle is in excruciating pain. Now Stevens hit him a second time, right between the eyes. Castle is gushing blood. - GT: What's that music? I know that tune. It's "Hail to the Chief." It can't be!
- GS: It is. It's President Donald Trump. I can't believe it!
- RN: Why? He's a WWE Hall of Famer.
- GT: Trump has a microphone.
- DT: I'd like to thank all of you for coming out to my nation's capitol to watch the greatest pay-per-view ever. I know so many of you voted for me. In fact, it was probably every one of you who voted for me.
- BS: Shut up! Shut up!
- GT: Wow, Stevens has a lot of nerve interrupting the President of the United States.
- BS: You are the problem with this great nation. You are not making America great again. You're making it worse! No Kings. No Kings! I only want to hear two words from you tonight.
- DT: What two words would those be?
- BS: I quit!!!!!
- GT: That's it. Stevens just quit. The match is over!
- DT: Well, it appears we have a winner. This fine young man (gestures towards Norman the Loon, whose handlers are putting him in a straight jacket) is the new number one contender to the CWL title. Very fitting. Vermin like you are not patriots. You don't deserve a shot at the title.
- GS: I think Stevens has had all he can stand. He charges at President Trump, but Secret Service agents take him down. They're escorting him out of the arena.
- DT: God bless the CWL, and God bless America.
- GT: Norman "the Loon" Kevcus is the new number one contender.
- RN: He'd raise his hands in victory, I'm sure, but his hands are being restrained in that straight jacket.

Winner: Norman "the Loon" Kevcus (498) beat The American Patriot (490), Midnight Scorpion (495), Barry "USA" Stevens (497) and Titus Castle (494)

CWL Tag Title Match Demolition Crew vs. Millennial Reign vs. Von Snapps

- GT: This one features two legendary teams, both of which have a legitimate claim at being the best ever in wrestling history. Then you have a newer team. The reigning CWL Tag Team of the Year, Millennial Reign.
- GS: This one has some strange rules. One man from each team can be in the ring at the same time like regular triple threat match, but they will be able to tag their partners. Whichever wrestler earns a pinfall wins it for their team and any wrestler from any other team can be pinned.
- RN: You're telling me that Demolition Crew don't even have to be pinned to lose their titles? That's not fair!
- GS: I don't make the rules. I just read them. That was an executive order from Lazarus Lane.
- GT: There's the bell and Mike Gloom immediately goes after Alex Von Snapp. Bennie Factor just went back to the corner next to Arty Fischel and is watching it all unfold
- GS: They're beating the hell out of each other.
- RN: Millennial Reign are smart. They'll just let them beat each other up and then pin them. Gloom tags in Zenith and now Zenith and Alex Von Snapp are going after Bennie Factor. Now it's the two legends teaming up to take down the young lions. (20 Minutes Later)

- GS: That's why these three teams are the best in the business. They're doing all they can to keep the fresh man again.
- GT: Now the legal men are Axel Von Snapp, Arty Fischel, and Shayne Zenith. Zenith just gave Fischel a massive power bomb and Fischel rolled out of the ring.
- RN: What's Victor doing? He's giving Alex some pointers.

 Alex has his back turned to the ring talking to Victor.

 Now Zenith whips Axel into the corner, but he just ran into Alex and sent him to the floor.



- GT: Alex's throat hit that metal ring barricade. He's having trouble breathing. Axel and Victor are out trying to help Alex. He can't breathe. Get someone out here, quick!
- GS: In the ring, the match is still going. What the hell is Arty Fischel doing?
- GT: He and Bennie Factor just pulled their iPhones out of their trunks and they're recording what's going on.
- GS: Bennie Factor slides out of the ring to get a closer view.
- GT: Meanwhile, Gloom and Zenith have just grabbed Fischel.
- RN: That punch just knocked Fischel's phone into the fourth row! Grab that. It's worth a fortune.
- GT: The Demolition Crew just gave Fischel the Wrecking Ball.
- GS: Bennie Factor is still filming the carnage. Axel is worried about Alex.
- GT: 1...2....3. This one's over. Demolition Crew retain.
- GS: These guys are further cementing their legacy.
- RN: It'll be another legends against young lions match when they face the Triple Six Rebels.

Winner: Demolition Crew (512) defeated Millennial Reign (508) and the Von Snapps (504)

CWL Six-Man Tag Title Match Nutty Bunnies vs. Triple Six Rebels

- GT: Now the six-man tag titles are on the line as the Nutty Bunnies face off against the Triple Six Rebels.
- RN: This isn't fair. Titus Castle has already wrestled twice.

 Titanous has wrestled once. I lodge a protest!
- GS: What do you care, Cranium?
- GT: I will agree that the Triple Six Rebels don't look fresh.

 Manny Nuff will start the match against one of the
 Bunnies.
- RN: That's Nutty Bunny 1.
- GT: How can you tell?
- RN: How can you not. This isn't fair, though. Titus Castle probably has a concussion after those chair shots earlier.
- GS: He didn't have to compete, but he's showing his toughness by competing yet again tonight. (15 Minutes Later)

- GS: The Nutty Bunnies have been dominant against the worn-out Triple Six Rebels. The Bunnies have used their experience to take out Manny Nuff and Titanous. We still haven't seen Titus Castle.
- GT: Nutty Bunny 3 is working over Titanous. He drills him with a DDT. Now he runs over and punches Manny Nuff. Manny tries to enter the ring but the referee is holding him back. Meanwhile, Titanous is crawling over and tags in Titus Castle.
- GS: This guy shouldn't even be wrestling. He has a concussion. He can barely make it through the ropes.
- GT: All three Nutty Bunnies in. Now all three Rebels in the ring, too. Nutty Bunny 3 nails Titus Castle with a DDT.
- GS: Castle isn't moving.
- GT: The referee finally restores order. Now he sees Castle laving motionless.
- GS: The ref is stopping this one. He's calling for medics.
- RN: They've been busy tonight. Is it a full moon?
- GT: The Nutty Bunnies have retained yet again.
- GS: They have to face some fresh team, not a team where half the team had matches earlier in the card!
- GT: The Nutty Bunnies are making their case for the best ever six-man in the CWL!

Winner: Nutty Bunnies (514) over T6R: Manny Nuff, Titus Castle, and Titanous (513)

Interview with Dakawande Boombaye

- GT: Now for a special interview with a man who has been silent for months, let's go backstage to Pam Paulshock.
- Pam Paulshock (bright, smiling):
- "Ladies and gentlemen, please welcome my guest at this time—'The King of the Concrete Jungle'...

 Dakawandeshe Boombaye!"
- [Boombaye steps into frame, stoic and calm, ready to speak—when—WHAM!]

RICKY SPANISH FROM OUT OF NOWHERE!



A steel chair cracks across Boombaye's back, buckling his knees before he can even speak. The audience erupts in horror.

Pam screams, "Stop it! Ricky, stop!"

Spanish spins around, fist clenched—and Pam Paulshock nearly gets punched out of instinct. She throws her microphone, stumbles backward, and runs off sobbing.

Ricky Spanish (snarling, into the camera):

"LUTHOR ALEXANDER SAYS HELLO!"

With no hesitation, Ricky lifts Boombaye up into the air—CRADLE TO THE GRAVE! The jumping cradle piledriver smashes Boombaye's head into the concrete backstage floor. But Ricky isn't done. He stands over the motionless Boombaye, cold and furious. He kicks him in the skull. Hard.

A moment of eerie silence follows—before security and paramedics rush in.

Paramedic (off mic):

"I think he's not breathing—somebody check for a pulse!"

The camera cuts away immediately.

CWL Internet Title Match Battle Axe vs. Double D Christoph

- GT: Here we go for the Internet title.
- GS: Double D Christoph came up just short last pay-per-view for the CWL World title and got duped out of Brawl For It All Win by Bennie Factor, but his second place finish earned him this title match.
- GT: Battle Axe will bring his experience and aggression.
- RN: Double D will bring his...double D's.
- GS: Will you stop? (10 minutes later)
- GT: This match has been action-packed. Both of these men are having to rely on their stamina here, as they've stood toe to toe and exchanged blows, exchanged suplexes, and both men have taken everything the other has thrown at him.
- GS: Now Double D has control after he rolled out of the way of legdrop. He's giving Battle Axe bionic elbows to the head.
- GT: Double D sends Battle Axe into the ropes. D ducks down for a bodydrop but Battle Axe flips over him. Sunset flip. 1...2....Oh, that was so close!
- RN: Axe almost surprised him!

- GT: Now Battle Axe is in control. He's using power moves and body shots to wear Double D down.
- RN: Every time he hits him, the Double D's shake!
- GS: Battle Axe slams Christoph to the mat. Now Battle Axe is going to the top. He's going to come off with an elbow.
- GT: Double D caught him with a blow to the midsection and flipped Battle Axe ever. Now Double D is stalking Battle Axe, just waiting for him to get up.
- GS: There's the "D" Jab!
- RN: What did you call him? A "D" bag?
- GS: No, I said "D" Jab, and that should be it.
- GT: 1...2....3. This pay-per-view ends a lot better for Double D than the last one, with him holding the CWL Internet title high.
- GS: We have a new champion, Double "D" Christoph!

WINNER: Double D Christoph (494) over Battle Axe (491)

<u>CWL World Title Match</u> <u>"Nature Boy" Phil Landers vs.</u> <u>"Late Night" Logan Kane</u>

- GT: Now it's time for the main event.
- RN: The champ is here! The Nature Boy. Whooooo!
- GS: We're not supposed to be biased, Cranium.
- RN: Worry about yourself, Gibbon!
- GT: Kane is in the ring. He looks ready, but he also looks a little distracted.
- GS: He's looking around, like he's looking for someone.
- GT: He's looking for the Chameleon.
- GS: Speaking of the Chameleon, the fans are going wild as the cameras show The Chameleon sitting in a suite with Deebo Samuel, Jayden Daniels, Sheldon Day, Matt Gay, Javon Kinlaw and other members of the Washington Commanders.
- RN: He has to forget about the Chameleon. He has the chance to win the CWL World Heavyweight title. He can't be thinking about the Chameleon.



- GT: Here comes the champ, and he's focused.
- GS: Logan Kane has called Phil Landers a Ric Flair wannabe. Landers is going to do everything tonight to prove he's not.
- GT: There's the bell. Landers extends his hand to Kane. Kane is getting ready to shake it, but Landers pulls his hand back and fixes his hair, while yelling "Whooooo" in Kane's face.
- GS: That made Kane mad and he charged Landers, kicking him in the gut, body slams him to the mat, then sends him into the ropes and gives him a press into a slam.
- GT: Landers backs into the corner on his knees. He has his hands up in surrender, yelling "Noooo" to Kane.
- GS: He's begging Kane to stop.
- GT: Now Kane whips Landers into the corner. Landers flips upside down over the turnbuckle, lands on his feet, and crosses the ring to the top turnbuckle.
- GS: Kane catches him though. Landers is begging no, but Kane throws him off the top. Now Kane is bludgeoning Landers with right hands. Landers stands up, takes three steps toward Kane, and now falls flat on his face.
- RN: The Nature Boy is in trouble here! (25 minutes later)
- GT: This one has been all Logan Kane, but he hasn't been able to put the Nature Boy away.
- RN: I've never seen the Nature Boy in this much trouble. If he doesn't mount some offense, this one will be over soon and we'll have a new champion.
- GS: Landers has had a few moments of offense, but nothing close to what it's going to take to put away a superstar the caliber of Logan Kane.
- GT: Kane has been trying to set up for the Punchline, but hasn't been able to hit it yet.
- GS: Now Kane hits a brutal clothesline on Landers.
- GT: He's setting him up. Punchline!
- GS: This one is over. 1...2...3!
- RN: No! No! No!
- GT: I don't think he got him. It was close, but Landers got his shoulder up at the last second.
- GS: The fans can't stand Kane, but they like him better than Landers. They're in shock. They thought this one was over, too.
- GT: Looks who's ringside. SDB Chips also thought it was over.

 He's got the belt. He's on the apron trying to hand the

 CWL World title belt to Kane.

- RN: Landers didn't lose, you idiot.
- GT: Well SDB doesn't realize it. The Night Owls don't realize it. They're ringside celebrating. The referee is trying to let them know that Kane didn't win.






COMMISSIONER TITLE RULES

If the League champion is already the CWL World champion or is already in the #1 Contender match, the commissioner reserves the right to substitute another competitor.
- 3) The #1 Contender to the CWL Internet title is determined by a number one contender match at the pay-per-view. The competitors are the CWL TV champion the cycle of the pay-per-view writeup and the following two cycles. If the TV champion is already the CWL Internet champion or is already in the #1 Contender match, the commissioner reserves the right to substitute another competitor.
- 4) Challengers to the CWL Tag titles and Six-Man titles are determined at the commissioner's discretion. Factors taken into consideration are trash talk, League and TV titles, and overall rankings for the year.
- 5) Unless otherwise announced, the wrestler with the highest score wins the title. In the event of a tie, the match is considered a draw and the challenger will be a part of the title match at the next pay-per-view.



While your great country carries the weight of the world on its shoulders by having the balls to drop bombs on Iranian nuclear sites, you all are so wrapped up in that one time that your President hurt your feelings that you'd rather entrench yourselves with terrorists than demonstrate an ounce of actual patriotism. You all make us sick and we've had enough of it. Our goal is simply to Make England Great Again and in order to do that, we realize that we have to combat socialism and combat liberalism.

<u>CLYDE</u>: "The Continental Wrestling League has both the fortune and mispleasure of being our stomping ground. We're here on a mission and that is to..."

ALL THREE: "We're going to to Make England Great Again!"

At a CWL live event in the KeyBank Center, "9 to 5" by Dolly Parton begins to play over the PA system. Zeb and Siena Martin make their way to the ring. Zeb has a mic in hand, white t-shirt and jeans: just the Watson Mill Kid lookin' weary but determined. Siena is dressed somewhat athletically, decked out in a peach-colored Sienamart windbreaker. They enter the ring and address the Buffalo audience.

ZEB: Hey y'all. This ain't gonna be one o' them speeches with a lot of fireworks. But I got somethin' weighin' on me, and I reckon it's time I say it out loud. Me and Mike Mason? We done been at each other's throats for near 'bout a year now. Ever since I walked into CWL, it's like our paths was meant to collide—and then just keep on smashin' into each other, month after month.

The audience gives a rumble of recognition. A few folks yell "Mason Enterprises sucks!"

ZEB: Between the sneak attacks, the wedding chaos, y'all dumpin' my drawers across the parkin' lot? Me'n Siena been stuck in this loop. And I'll save the bull with y'all. Every time I start gettin' a little momentum? I get pulled back into this. And I can't be the man I'm supposed to be, not in the Continental Rasslin League, not in the IWAR. Not if I keep lettin' this happen.

He takes a breath. The crowd quiets a bit, sensing something bigger in his tone.

ZEB: So Mike. Johnny. Vince. I'm callin' y'all out here tonight. Not for a fight. Not to settle the score. But to put it behind us. 'Cause I got yer answer to the question you been askin'.

Without missing a beat, the Mason Enterprises theme hits. With a businesslike demeanor, the three IWAR mainstays begin to walk out. Mike is calm and smooth, Johnny is smug, and Vincent stone-faced. They enter the ring as Zeb keeps his eyes locked on Mike "Freakin" Mason

ZEB: I ain't gonna lie, Mike. I thought long and hard 'bout your offer. You said I could be part of somethin' bigger. And you might be right. But I'd have to compromise who I am. And I just can't do that. I ain't built for shortcuts. I ain't built to follow orders from folks who don't see people – they only see profits. So my answer on joinin' Mason Enterprises? I reckon no.

The crowd erupts in a loud cheer, thankful that Zeb is firm on not selling out his ideals. Siena nods quietly next to him.

ZEB: But I'm hopin' we can be men about it. You can respect my answer, and we shake hands like grown folks and leave this in the rearview mirror. And we put an end to the B.S. between us fer good.

Zeb extends his hand. Long pause. Mike slowly steps forward. A hush falls over the crowd.

MIKE: Well, Zeb. That's disappointing to hear. But I can respect your decision, especially since you brought me out here like a man to do it face to face. Fine. We'll go our separate ways after tonight.

He takes Zeb's hand. The two shake. Mike turns to leave—then subtly gestures behind his back.

BAM!

Vincent Torrio clocks Zeb with a brutal short-arm lariat!

GIBBON: NO! Come on now—AGAIN with this?!

GORDON: Wait... look at this! They aren't piling on like they normally would. What's goin' on here?

Johnny the Wrench restrains Siena: not violently, just enough to keep her from interfering. Vincent and Mike each land a single stomp on Zeb's prone body. Then they stop. No chair. No finishers. Just the bare minimum to leave a mark. It's then that Mike kneels next to Zeb with the microphone up to his lips.

MIKE: You made your choice. Just remember what that feels like.

He gently pats Zeb's chest and rises. Johnny places a folded Sienamart flyer into Zeb's hand. Siena finally breaks free and dives over Zeb's body as Mason Enterprises walks out to a chorus of layered boos.

GIBBON: I'm at a bit of a loss for words here! This was nothing like the carnage they've displayed on Zeb and Siena Martin before. It was near tame!

GORDON: I'm not sure what the intent is behind this play from Mason Enterprises, but my guess is that this isn't the last that we've seen of this saga!





Our scene begins in the Late Night green room. Logan Kane sits stiffly on a folding chair, drinking a latte from a chipped mug that says *I Hate My Co-Host*. SDB-Chips is across the room filming a TikTok, doing reps with a championship belt made of Takis bags and LED

CHIPS: Yoooo what's good fam, it's ya boy SDB-Chips, live from the pre-show with Logan Kane, lookin' like he just lost a championship match to anxiety!

KANE: I'm thrilled to be here. Truly. Nothing screams professionalism like influencer cardio in a hallway.

CHIPS: Ayy, I'm the people's algorithm, bruh. Gotta keep the bag movin'. Anyway, this interview with Big Bad Bob? Bout to be must-see.

KANE: If he shows up sober and wearing pants, I'll be shocked."

The door immediately slams open. A fog machine kicks on. Neither Logan nor SDB are sure how a fog machine got in there by the looks on their faces. Suddenly, Big Bad Bob struts in wearing a leather jacket over a shirtless torso, ripped jeans, UW "World" Title over his shoulder, aviators on indoors, and a Bluetooth earpiece with no phone connected. He is absolutely glowing with delusion.

BBB: Alright, peasants. King Bob has arrived.

KANE: Uh...we don't do pyro in the green room.

BBB (completely ignoring him, as usual): No eye contact unless you're crying. Where's my custom UW-branded vegan hummus I specifically requested on my rider? The lavender one, not the lemon.

CHIPS: Wait. Did you bring your own fog machine and put it in here earlier?"

BBB: Did UW bring their own fog machine to *Tokyo Slam '96*? Don't ask dumb questions, Chips Ahoy.

KANE: There is no such thing as Tokyo Slam '96.

Bob pulls out a rolled-up scroll, completely ignoring Logan once again.

BBB: Tonight's intro. Read it exactly as written. I want drones, orbs, and a choir of orphaned werewolves. Or hot babes dressed as orphaned werewolves. Whatever you got laying around in the back here.

CHIPS: Yooooooo. What?

BBB: Also, I will not be seated during the interview. I'll be standing on a podium built from CWL reject merch. That's synergy.

KANE (flustered): My god...

BBB: UW! UW! I am the fourth rope. I am the mat. I am the concept of heat.

A long pause. SDB and Logan slowly turn toward each other. For the first time, their expressions match: stunned disbelief. Logan motions to his cohost to sneak outside, leaving Bob alone. Now, in the middle of the room with his shirt off, he begins to talk into a pretend microphone to no audience in particular.

BBB: And what a night it's been! The crowd chanting my name, the lights catching my glisten just right. Classic Bob, really. 'Tell me, Bob. How do you stay so humble?' I don't, Pam Rose. Humility is for the mid-card.

Meanwhile, outside of the door...

KANE: This man is clinically unwell. I'm pulling the interview.

CHIPS: Naw, fam. You pull that, you kill the bag.

KANE: What in the #%* & does that even mean, anyway? The bag? You make no sense.

CHIPS: Bruh. Do you hear this? This man just cut a promo on himself. Shirtless. In the green room. While interviewing an invisible version of himself. This ain't an interview, bro. It's CONTENT. Viral. Clickable. Shareable. The algorithm's already salivatin'. You think CWL fans are wild? Wait till the UW conspiracists show up in the comments section.

KANE: Fine. You want to be part of a circus? That's your call. I don't need to be humiliated on my own show.

CHIPS: Too late. You already let me co-host. But if we ride this right? We both come out hotter than ever.

A long beat. Kane mutters something about ulcers and storms out, but Chips just smiles, slowly panning his phone camera toward Bob.

CHIPS: Later Night bout to go megaviral, baby. Let. Him. Cook.

We find none other than "Doug's Blind Big Brother" Craig sitting alone on a bench, bruised and still recovering from the vicious attack from the Nameless Minions of Solace. Mr. Fig Newtons sits beside him, wires sparking slightly but functional. There's silence before Craig finally speaks, his voice low.

Meanwhile, we cut scenes to outside the locker room. Doug paces nervously. Roman Reinv stands still, hands behind his back, looking like he's preparing to address the Senate.



DOUG: Look, we gotta say something. If we walk in there and just say 'whoops,' he's gonna snap.

REINV: Fear not, Douglas. I hath conceived a tale most persuasive, forged from the scrolls of divine necessity. When Craig doth question, we shall answer with the weight of ancient fate.

DOUG: You're just gonna wing it again, huh?

They enter. Craig doesn't look up. He's not angry. He's just done.

CRAIG: **** *** **** : *** : *** : ****

REINV: Indeed, good Craig. Verily, thou must know. We were summoned by celestial decree to the outskirts of sanctified territory, where a vision most dire did cometh unto me. The Oracle of Linoleum did speaketh in tongues of fire, and bade us seek the Seventh Shadow! A Nameless Minion lost to time and treachery, whose presence could unravel the very fabric of wrestlingeth itself.

DOUG: Totally happened. Oracle. Big fire. Lotta, uh...riddles and stuff.

Craig finally lifts his eyes, brow furrowed in disbelief.

REINV: Thou must understand—had we not heedeth this quest, doom may have found thee thrice fold!

But I'm the assassin creeping up behind.

Some of you are asking—how is Ricky Spanish back? Let me explain something real simple.

Ricky Spanish is an American professional wrestler, convicted felon, murderer and former gang enforcer, best known for his time in the International Wrestling Association (IWA) and its subsidiary promotions within the IWAR network. Standing at 6 feet 6 inches and weighing 280 pounds, he is notorious for his violent outbursts, criminal past, and unpredictable behavior both inside and outside the ring. Spanish is a former tag team champion and a former member of the infamous Revolution Extreme (RX) faction, widely regarded as its most dangerous asset.

Early Life

Ricky Spanish was born in a housing project hallway in the Bronx, New York. At the age of four, he relocated to the Brownsville Housing Projects in Brooklyn. His early life was marked by severe trauma: his father was killed in a shootout with police, and his mother died of a drug overdose shortly thereafter.

By age five, Ricky was fighting for money on the streets. At seven, he killed a rival fighter, and by thirteen, he had killed again, this time executing a piledriver on concrete during an alley fight. These acts began a cycle of incarceration that would define much of his early life.

Revolution Extreme (RX)

Revolution Extreme was already a dominant and controversial faction within the IWAR long before Ricky Spanish became involved. After years of existence, Luthor Alexander, the group's charismatic and dangerous leader, orchestrated a daring prison break using a solid gold helicopter.

During this operation, Luthor freed Ricky Spanish, his cellmate Carlos Danger, and former martial arts champion Soul Train Jones. Impressed by Ricky's violent ferocity, Luthor brought him into RX as its most volatile member.

Ricky formed a tag team with Carlos Danger called The BQ Express, and together they captured:

*CWL Tag Team Championship

* IWL Tag Team Championship

When RX eventually disbanded, Ricky voluntarily returned to prison-not under custody, but by choice. Luthor Alexander purchased the prison, turning it into a personal training ground, importing the world's most dangerous criminals just so Ricky could fight them.


Ricky's promos are often chaotic, emotionally raw, and filled with violent imagery. He speaks openly about addiction, trauma, and destruction.

Return to IWAR: Executive Order


At the CWL pay-per-view Executive Order, Ricky Spanish made a shocking and violent return to the IWAR. In the middle of a live broadcast, he appeared without warning and smashed a steel chair over journalist Akeem Bix enspan's head, knocking him unconscious and splitting the chair in half. Spanish then grabbed a microphone and delivered one of the most disturbing promos in IWAR history: "I'm tired of this f*ing clown show. I've been sitting in a cell for months, watching what the IWAR has become. Where are the warriors? Where are the fighters?"* He openly declared that Luthor Alexander sent him to kill CWL Commissioner Lazarus Lane, not to win titles, but to inflict pain. He also targeted Barry Stevens, calling him a fraud and vowing to destroy him. This promo sparked a wave of controversy and reignited interest in Spanish's future.

Legacy

Ricky Spanish is considered one of the most feared, violent, and controversial wrestlers in the IWA's long history. A mythic figure to some and a cautionary tale to others, his presence in the ring signals danger, chaos, and brutality. Despite his volatility, his name is etched into the history books of both IWL and CWL, with no signs of fading away.

INTERN: Mr. Kane? **SDB-Chips** wants to know if you want to sit in on the pre-interview for **Big Bad Bob**'s upcoming appearance.

Kane snaps.

KANE: God%\$@(*&^@#%\$!*)^%#\$@)!!!




