





This recording took place on Card 9 (cycle #278) held in Deadwood. The opening bout was a singles match between **Jigger** and **Mr. Money in the Bank Arlo Swank** that ended in a tie due to a Double Count Out. Camera crew caught up with **Jigger** back in the locker room shortly after the match was over. **Fat Andy** and **Bowl God** are attempting to calm Jigger down as he seems to be in a rage.

Jigger: I can't believe that ended in a draw! I am the better athlete and should have won that match!!

Fat Andy: It'll be ok bro, you'll get him next cycle.

Bowl God: Well, you did have him right where you wanted him, but then you exited the ring to try and flirt with **Miss Adrian**. That was why **Arlo** jumped over the top rope and started brawling with you. That ultimately led to a double count-out..

Jigger: (looks **Bowl God** in the face with a murderous rage)

Fat Andy: Just take a deep breath in. **Bowl God** isn't the enemy, he just wants to help. Losses aren't the end of the world. Take me for example, I actually lost to **Joe Tusa** and had to give up my United States belt at the same time.. No one loses to him, yet you don't see me getting all ragey...

Jigger: You are right, **JCT** sucks! (all three grapplers start laughing and the mood starts to lighten up). At least you haven't lost to **Sheriff Gerald McFaul**, **Bud Hlavin**, or any of those other geezers! It'd be hard to walk around with your head up after those losses...

Bowl God: Why are there so many geezers in this league? Does GWL secretly stand for Grandpa's Wrestling League?

Jigger: There are a lot of old bucks in this league, both good and bad. You guys see that **COT** is trying to take over as the dominate stable here?

Fat Andy: COT is tough, they have accumulated a lot of stars! I heard some of their wrestlers were actually having trouble counting that high and that's why they formed **COT**, which stands for **C**ount **O**ur **T**oes... Anyways, you guys remember when we formed a stable back in our **MIL** days? Should we be forming alliances in the GWL so that COT doesn't gain control?

Bowl God: Only wrestlers I talk to from the **GWL** are the ones who come to me for the greenery. And they like to keep it discreet given that pot is not yet legal in all areas of the world...

Jigger: Yea, I'm not sure if anyone likes us in here, not because we're bad people, but because we are hard to keep up with when we start partying...

Fat Andy: (looks directly at the camera) Can you keep up with us??? If so, meet us at the Executive Club in New York City this weekend..

Bowl God: Let's get outta here. I rolled up this fatty and don't wanna get in trouble for lighting up indoors again...

(screen fades to commercial break as the three studs head for the nearest exit...)

John "Big Cat" Irons: (Bringing his luggage into the arena.) I'm sure you are going to ask am I ready for the best of five series. Listen, Electron Warrior is one of the most accomplish wrestlers on the roster. The man delivers every night, 24-7, 365 days in the year. I had better be ready or he's gonna hand me my a**. Titles, money are all gonna be at stake, but isn't that why we all got into this game. Seriously, some of us love the fans, some of us love the haterade of the fans, but all of us do it for the glory. No pain, no glory, but at the end of the day there will be a winner and their will be respect! Sometime the desire to be the best is the storyline. Now use that for click bait. Ha! Ha! The fans of the GWL deserve the best five match series ever!

Joe Tusa: Check this out, everybody, I'm the U.S. Champ and the Million Dollar Champ! Fabulous Richard Hard! I finally got even with you! I'm moving on for bigger horizons now! I want to be the World Champion someday, and by God, I will be!



Tom Bradford Sr., I don't know what the hell you were thinking when you threw me out of the Battle Royal, but when I get my stinkin' hands on you, you're gonna wish you weren't in professional wrestling. You and I are going to wrestle one on one at Royal Rumble, whether you like it or not, 'cause "Bulldog" Bud Carson is just that good! Throw me out of the ring again in the Battle Royal and I'll show you former TV actor what "Bulldog" Bud Carson is capable of doing to you when it comes to Big Time Wrestling! - "Bulldog" Bud Carson

(The scene opens late at night downstairs in room 13 where we find 90 year old white-haired Bud Carson, owner of the YMCA, laying down on his stomach inside the middle of a white-padded gold-roped wrestling ring in his black wrestling boots and extremely tight powder blue super shiny satin wrestling trunks. Then, we see 3 year old Cody Barlow climbing inside the squared circle in his black wrestling boots and extremely tight blue/silver plaid shiny satin wrestling trunks. Cody quickly goes over and sits down on Carson's right inner knee, grabs his right wrestling boot with both hands, and begins to pull and bend the foot and toes of Carson with all of his might, causing Carson to quickly put one hand over his eyes and slap the mat with his other hand 'cause the pain is very excruciating.)

Cody: "I've got you now, Mr. Bud Carson! I have you in my painful, punishing, bone crunching, mat-slapping toehold, and there is no escape! Grrr! Grrr!"

Bud Carson: "Ooh! Ouch! Ooch! Owww! Slap! Slap! Pain! Agony! Lots of ouch! Ooch! Owww! Wrestling torture! Foot! Foot! My precious toes! Ooch! Owww! Ooh, take it easy on-on me! I'm old and can't take pain so-so easily! Ouch! Ooch! Slap! Slap! Ouch! Ooh! Owww!"

Cody: "Putting you in a toehold, Mr. Carson, is like a dream come true for me! Bend toes! Pull foot! Crunch elderly toes! Make elderly man cry in lots of wrestling agony!"

Bud Carson: "Ooch! Ooh! Owww! Ooh! The crunching! The bending! Ouch! Ooch! Owww! Ooh! Slap! Slap! Should never let a 3 year old bend and crunch your foot and toes as if you're in a championship wrestling ooh! Owww! Ouch! Ooch! Ouch! Slap! Slap! Match! Ooh! Ooch! Ouch! Ooh! Owww! Slap! Slap! I-I think he-he broke my big toe!"

Cody: "Submit, Mr. Carson! Bend! Crunch toes! Pull foot! Make elderly man cry in lots of wrestling agony!"

Bud Carson: "I-I give! You-you win! Owww! Ooch! Ouch! Cody! Cody! Owww! Ooch! Ooh! Slap! Slap! Submit! Submit!" (Cody releases his painful, punishing, bone crunching toe crunching toehold he had on Mr. Bud Carson.)

Cody: "Now that was a wrestling work out! That was really fun!"

Bud Carson: "You weren't the one crying in lots of wrestling agony and slapping the mat for dear life!" (Cody helps Mr. Bud Carson up off the mat so he can get feeling back into his foot and toes.)

Cody: "I must say that you look really good in those extremely tight powder blue super shiny satin wrestling trunks, Mr. Carson."

Bud Carson: "Thanks, Cody! I have the same color, only in a pair of bathing suits."

Cody: "Mr. Carson, are you fully vaccinated?"

Bud Carson: "Yes, Cody, I am fully vaccinated."

Cody: "My grandpa is too! My dad called me and said next year we're going on a giant cruise line to the Caribbean, and I can't wait!"

Bud Carson: "I went to the western Caribbean on Norwegian back in 2008 and loved every moment of it!"

Cody: "I can't wait! I wonder how many cruise lines there are?"

Bud Carson: "A lot! You'll love the choices! And the variety of food...Yum!"

Cody: "All right! How about a mat-slapping Spinning Toehold, Mr. Carson?"

Bud Carson: "One wrestling hold is enough for me tonight, but next time you can put me in a Spinning Toehold or a Foot and Ankle Twister." Cody: "Foot and Ankle Twister – what's that?"

Bud Carson: "Bring your grandpa and tell him that Mr. Bud Carson wants to show him a painful, punishing wrestling hold inside the squared circle. Also, bring your camcorder and he and I will have a Big Time Senior Citizen's Wrestling match inside the squared circle."

Cody: "Mr. Carson, it's getting late. Wanna go home and watch wrestling?"

Bud Carson: "Midnight already? Let's go!" (Cody and Mr. Bud Carson climb out of the squared circle in their wrestling gear, change into their street clothes, and Cody quickly heads home on his bicycle while Mr. Bud Carson keeps an eye on the building until 2:00 in the morning.)

The GWL arena goes dark and then pyrotechnics explode. Through the smoke and flashes of light a figure emerges from the back. He strides confident to the ring. The four ring-corners explode with flames as Electron stands in the center.

Big Cat.... This is it! You and I will be starting our series in front of all these fans this cycle. I have a feeling this will go down as one, nay the, greatest series to ever take place within the confines of the GWL. You're a hell of a competitor - now let's do this.

Pyrotechnics explode from the ringposts again and he is gone.
