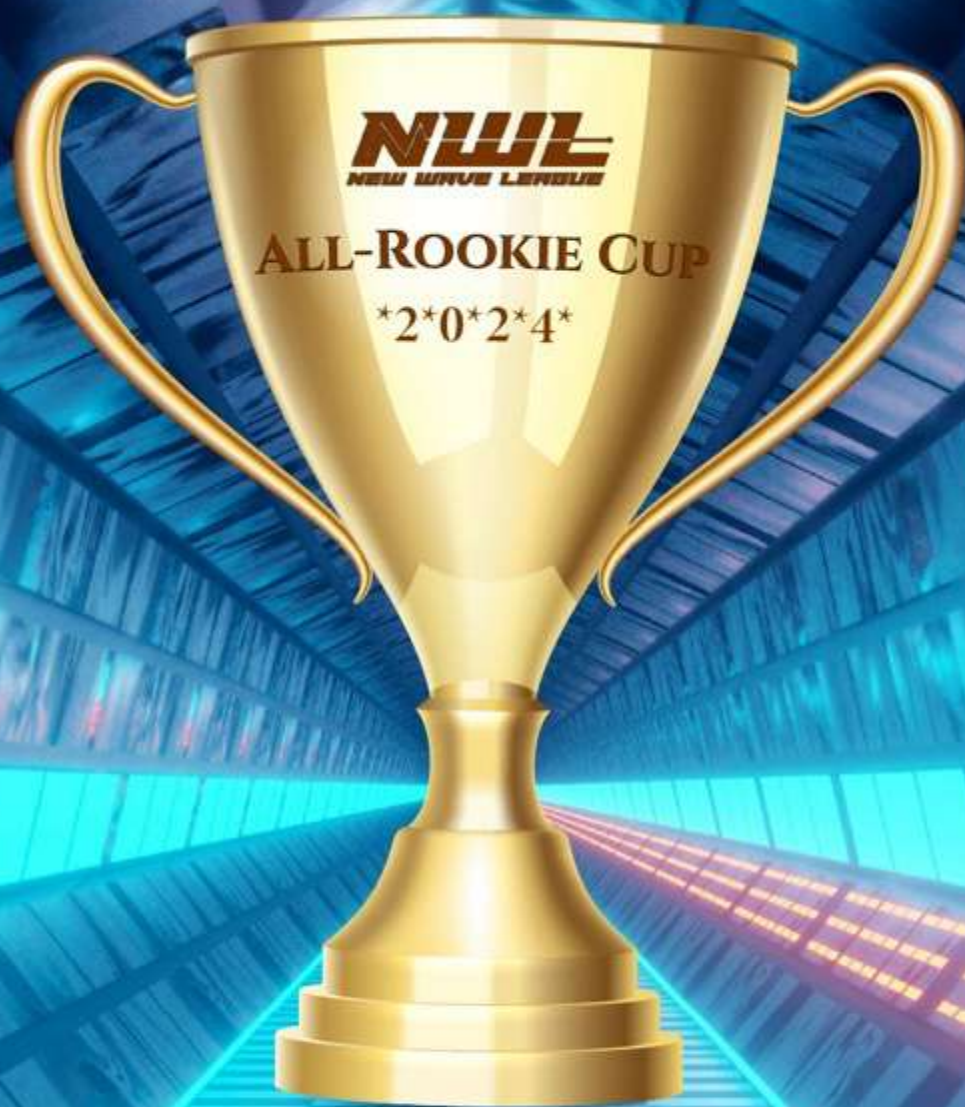

GOLD FEDERATION HOLD CHART

The IWA breaks the holds into two groups, your first 10 come from the Wear-down holds (#1-60) and your last five come from the Set-up holds (#61-90). You'll want to change your wrestler's strategy every cycle (round of play) as these values will go up and down from cycle to cycle. The IWA has six Federations, and the values are different in all, but to get started, we'll track the holds in the Gold Federation which is where the NWL resides. There are different ways to track the holds, so for our example we're using a simplified hold chart that we'll walk you through. (Note: Some players track *every* hold, but to start, we are only going to track the holds that score between 25-30 points or 41-45 points.)

This list what each hold was valued last cycle.

Tracking the previous 15 cycles can help you spot trends.

This shows the average for each hold over the past 15 cycles.

Hi and Lo gives a quick look at which holds do or don't do well.

Here is a quick strategy guide to get you started...

Strategy Vocabulary

Move number - The number on the left of the holds - this is the same every cycle. You write this number for your strategy when you send it to the IWA

Hold value - the number on the RIGHT of each hold number between 1-30 (for the front) and 31-45 (in the back) This is the number of **points** you get for your strategy to determine the results of the matches. This changes every cycle.

Drop - A move that you do not use OR the moves that are valued at 25 points (in the front) or less than 43 (in the back)

Strategy Quick Tips

In the front (Holds #1-60):

- Always take both 25pt and 30pt holds
- Choose TWO holds valued between 26-29 pts to

DROP

- ALWAYS take move #25 (Fallaway Slam)
- NEVER drop BOTH 29 pt holds
- Ignore anything less than 25pts

In the back (Holds #61-90):

- Always take both 45pt holds
- Always take hold #90 (Superplex)
- Take one 41pt hold
- Take one 43pt and one 44pt hold

Since 2012, the Willowick Classic has pitted the NWL's top stars in a tournament with a coveted spot in the Young Lions Triple Threat championship match going to the winner. To be eligible for the next Willowick Classic, wrestlers must be active, Trash talk and not have reached the finals before or held the Young Lions title previously. Unlike most of our other NWL events and match ups, this one is also determined by the strength of each wrestler's promos. *Does their promos tell us who they are, why they are in the NWL and what they will do to get? Does their promo mention other members of the roster? Does the promo respond to other promos? (especially if they called them out or mentioned them) Does their promo bring up the title/event they want to win? Does their promo build a world we can see? Does the promo advance the wrestler's persona, rivalries and feuds that shows growth?*

We know this is a lot to consider, but if done right, this can be done in a promo be it a full page or one paragraph. The NWL has plenty of titles that can be won with a great strategy score on the front page, but the Young Lion championship is part of the IWAR's Storytelling style of play and the winner should reflect that. In Behind the Scenes terms, the IWAR style of play is storyline so we look at whose promos tell a story and whose promos do not. I can tell you plainly, someone who doesn't trash talk, may be in the Willowick Classic, but they will never win the Willowick Classic. Good luck, -MR

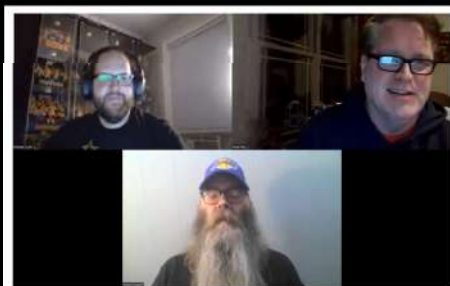
