Minnesota Wrecking Crew XV & XIV (c) def. Nemiah & Azaiah Umbra

The Umbra Brothers brought fire, backwoods fury, and a jar of mystery liquid—but the Champs brought gold-plated destruction. In a match full of suplexes, tag precision, and maybe a little voodoo, the Crew hit a devastating Spike Piledriver on Azaiah to retain the belts. The Wrecking Crew might be the most dangerous team in wrestling right now. Period.

Extreme Title Match

Kirk Lazarus (c) def. The Reaper Tristan Morrow

Main event time. A match soaked in violence, ego, and awards-season energy. Lazarus, fresh off his "Best Performance in a Skulldriver" nod, took everything The Reaper had—and survived. Tables were splintered, chairs were twisted, and Lazarus may have stabbed someone with a mini Oscar statue (we're still checking the footage). After ducking a sickle swing and landing a **Method Breaker Neck Snap**, Lazarus stood bloodied but victorious.

Expect chairs, chains, and possibly an Oscar to the face. This will be your **main event, your nightmare**, and your summer blockbuster.



The scene opens backstage. The PKW logo glows blood red behind a slab of a cinderblock wall. In front of it, there's "Dependable" Danny Doyle—sweatdrenched tee, taped fists, eyes locked on the camera like he's daring it to flinch.

"Y'all know the name. And if you don't? You're about to learn it the hard way. I'm **Dependable Danny Doyle**. And I didn't come to PKW to shake hands or trade shirts—I came to fight."
